Section 1: Do Now Instructions: Read the following article excerpt: Then answer the two questions below the article.
Article Excerpt: "Teens Report in a Survey That They Are Bullied and Harassed Online".  By Agence France-Presse, adapted by Newsela staff, Published:10/14/18
The Pew Research Center released survey results about online harassment and cyberbullying among U.S. teenagers. The Pew Research Center survey found that 59 percent of U.S. teens reported being bullied or harassed online. Sixty-three percent said it was a major problem for people their age.
The most common type of harassment cited was name-calling at 42 percent. Thirty-two percent of those who responded said someone had spread false rumors about them on the Internet. Sixteen percent said they had been the target of physical threats online.
Among teens surveyed, 1 in 4 said they had experience with explicit images. Some had received unwanted images or photos. Others had images of them shared without their permission or consent.
