Welcome to Hale! Use this course option sheet to request courses for next school year. Your 9th grade academy courses have been pre-selected for you, so you will be selecting math and electives. When you choose a course, you are signaling not only your interest, but also your commitment to complete that course to the best of your ability. You are requesting courses, not filling out your schedule. When you receive your schedule at the end of the summer, you may find courses in different order or semester than what is listed below.
