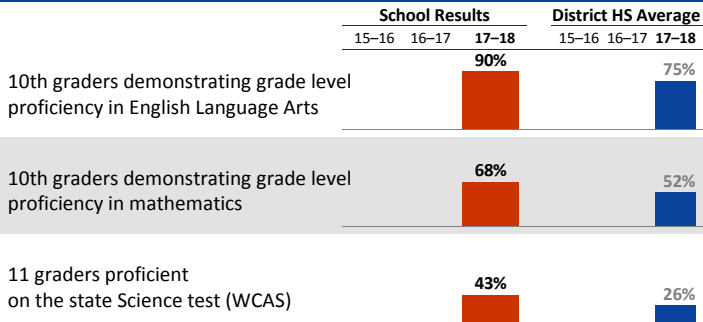

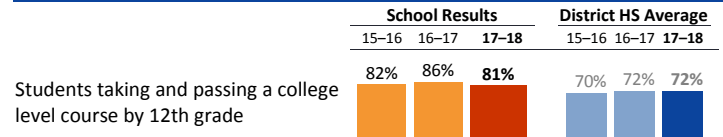

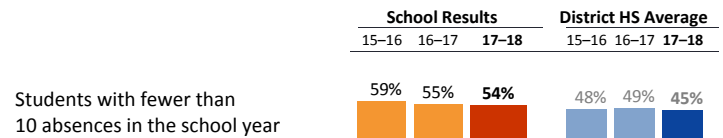

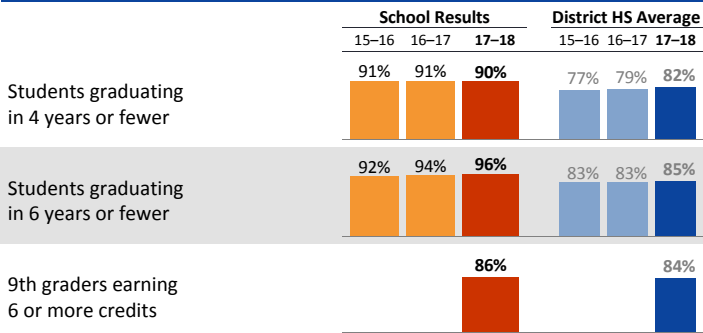

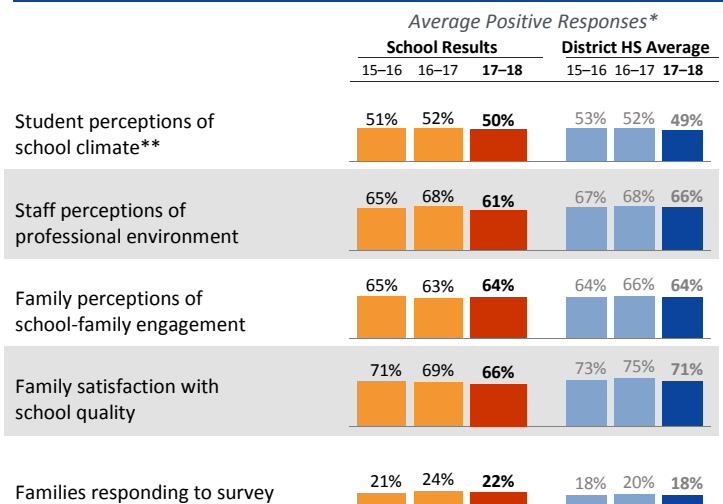
Attendance



On-Track for Graduation

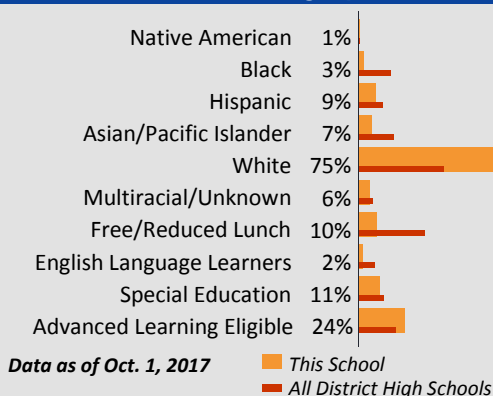


Student, Family, and Staff School Climate Survey

School Goals

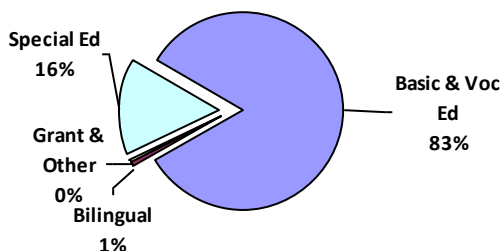
All students will develop positive relationships with adults and students at BHS through academic, extracurricular, and social opportunities. -All students will receive support – academic, social, cultural – in order to take on the challenges they will face, including college, career, and other endeavors. -All students and families will join with BHS to engage as partners in supporting and strengthening the school and greater community. -All students will develop individual strengths, achieve academic excellence, and be recognized for their successes.

School Description & Plan to Achieve Goals

Ballard is committed to eliminating opportunity gaps in our school and we believe that improving relationships between staff and students is an important first step in this improvement process; Once students feel that adults at Ballard care about them, they will be more likely to attend school and pass classes and be less likely to miss school due to suspension. Therefore, our C-SIP SMART Goals are: We will make the percentage of all students of color who receive Es proportional to the school population; The percentage of all students who are suspended will be proportional to the school population; By the end of the school year, 92% of our ninth graders will earn 5.5 credits.; The percentage of African-American and American Indian students that have less than an 80% attendance rate will decrease from 27.5% to 23.5%; For all students, we will increase the number of students who feel their teachers take time to get to know them from 49% to 60%. Ballard's commitment to eliminating opportunity gaps can be seen in our yearlong commitment to professional development in this area, including staff book studies from diverse authors and activities to improve relationships between staff and students. We are also working on efforts to make this commitment more public, so that our students see our efforts. Student clubs including Students and Teachers Against Racism and Multi-Cultural Club have joined Ballard's Race & Equity Team to address this issue.
