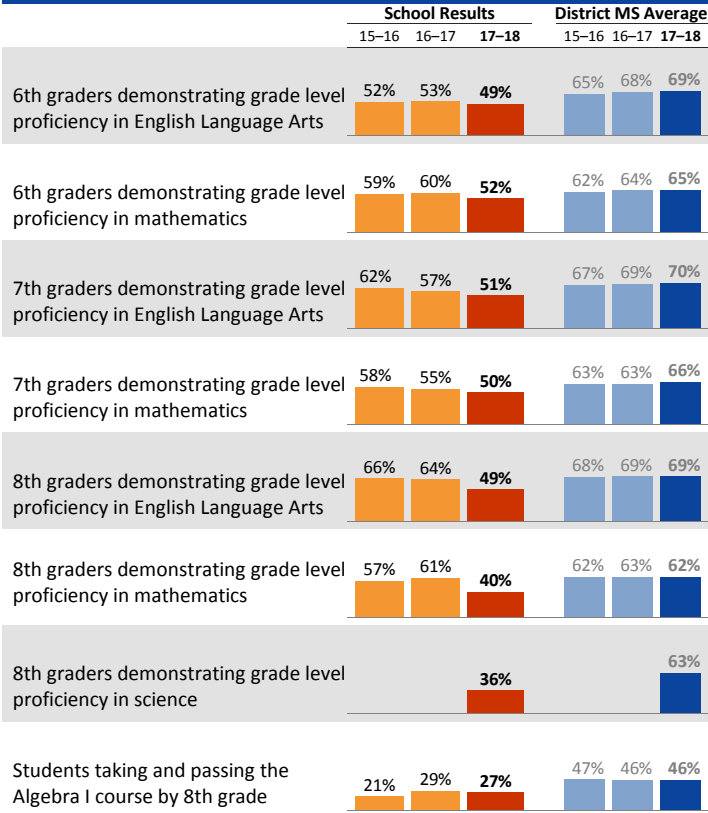

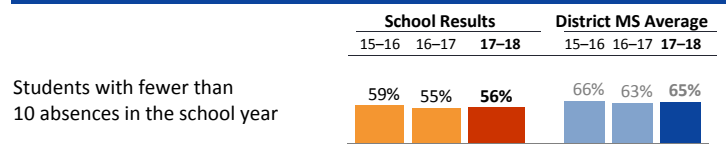

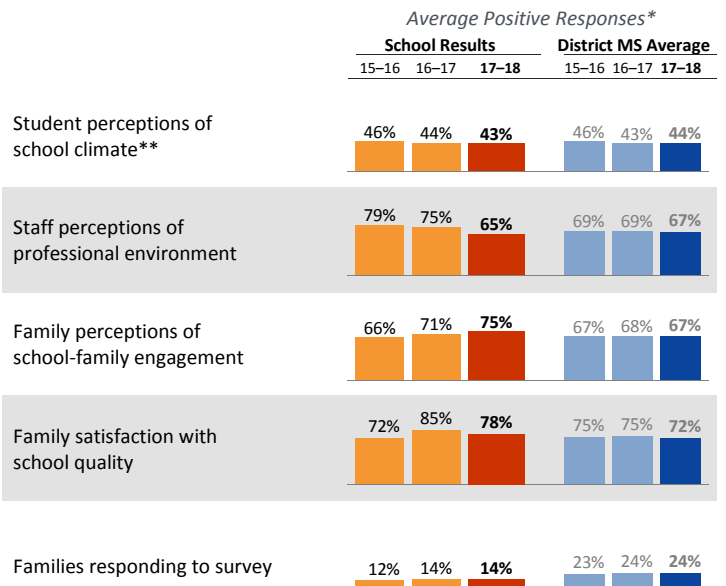

Attendance

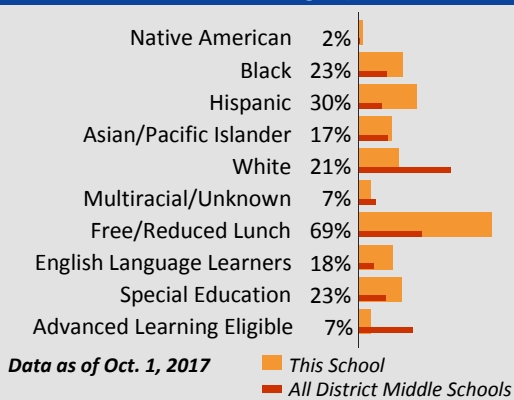


Student, Family, and Staff School Climate Survey

School Goals

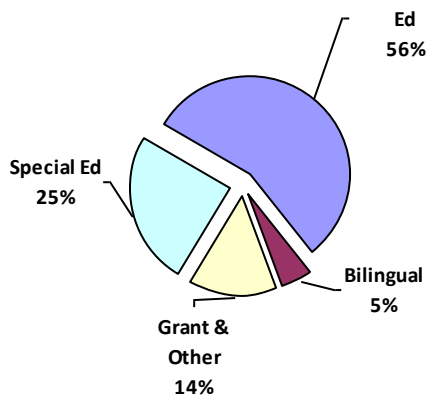

School Description & Plan to Achieve Goals

Denny International Middle School is a wonderfully diverse learning community focused on high academic expectations for all scholars. Our entire school community is committed to providing an outstanding education for each scholar, eliminating the opportunity gap, and infusing the celebration of our diversity into every day of learning. In the areas of math and science, Denny is increasingly a STEM (Science Technology Engineering and Math) school. In addition to our Gateways to Technology class, our science teachers at all three grade-levels are implementing a computer-based Amplify Science curriculum! In order to empower our scholars as readers and writers, we are continuing as an Affiliate School with Columbia Teachers' College in NY to bring Readers/Writers Workshop aligned to the Common Core State Standards to our classrooms! Other highlights include: Scholars in our Spanish Dual Language program are entering high school with on average three full years of high school Spanish already earned! Our Chinese program offers our scholars the chance to learn Mandarin from 6th through 12th grade at Chief Sealth. Our art and music programs are continuing to win awards! Important culturally-focused classes, such as Proyecto Saber, Šeqacib, and Kingmakers, offer cultural affirmation and leadership opportunities. Our free after school and summer programs extend learning and offer exciting extra curricular activities throughout the year. More and more of our outstanding teachers are earning the prestigious National Board certification!
