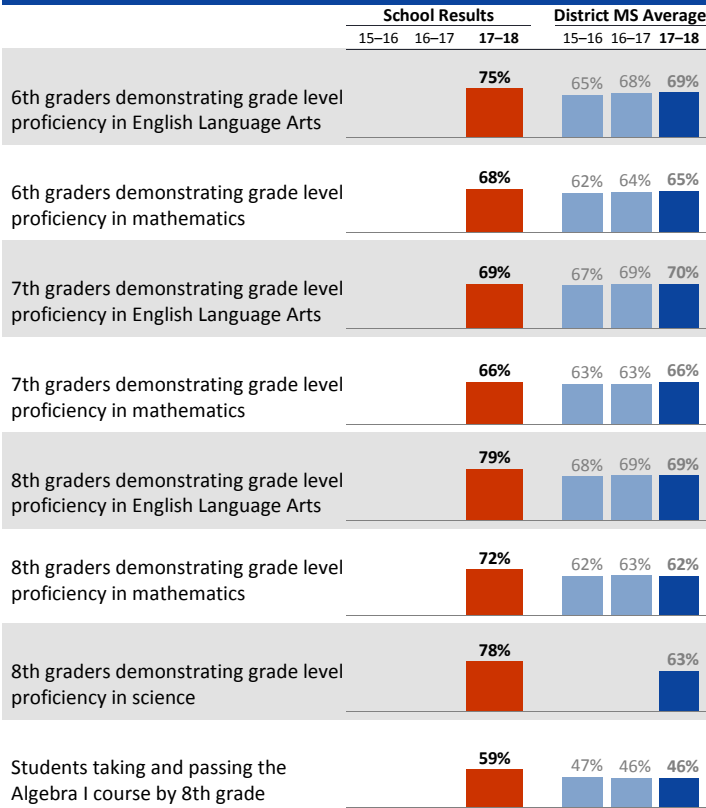

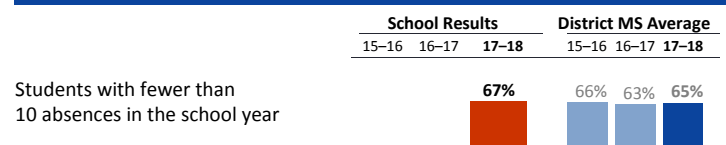

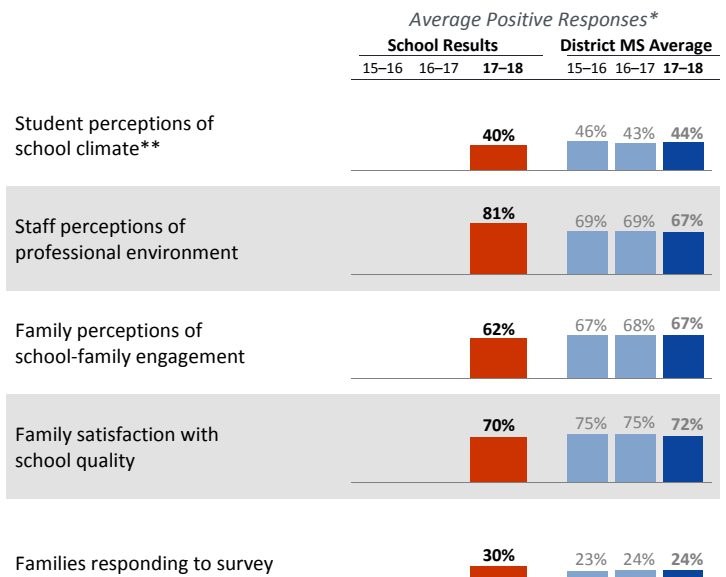

Attendance

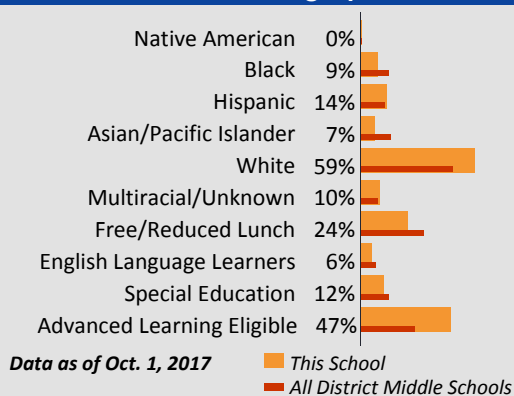


Student, Family, and Staff School Climate Survey

We are committed to equity and excellence for every student, and provide opportunities for each student to receive receive advanced learning opportunities and supports in every class every day.

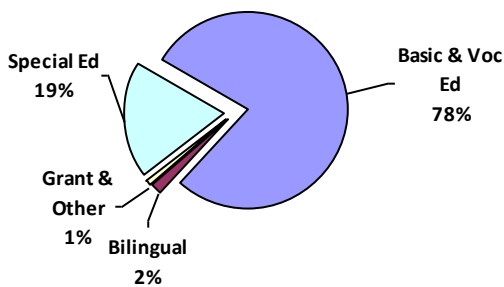
We provide innovative exploratory and elective opportunities, including Visual Art, STEM Engineering, Coding, Band, Orchestra, Guitar, Percussion, Leadership, Proyecto Saber, and World Language, including Spanish and Japanese. Students may begin studying World language in 6th grade, and can potentially enter high school with the equivalent of two years of world language.

We have a strong Physical Education program, and provide excellent instruction that allows students to meet and exceed PE standards.

Above all, we agree to SOAR as a community of Ravens: Scholars Show Ownership, Academic Focus, and Respect and Responsibility. Rather than focusing on rules, we ask students to reflect on these agreements daily, and build their skills so that they can establish, maintain, and restore relationships that support their learning and the learning of others.
