

# Superintendent Procedure 4200SP.D Public Use of Outside School Grounds

Members of the public, before or after school hours, may use outside school grounds for outdoor recreation, i.e., athletic tracks and fields. Use by the public is permitted in areas normally used for recreational activity when those facilities are not being used by District students or by outside groups that have reserved the space.

Members of the public who use outside school grounds are subject to the following conditions of use:

1. Outside school grounds are available for public use except:
  - a. During school hours;
  - b. When used by District students;
  - c. When reserved by outside groups; and
  - d. From dusk to dawn.
2. All persons on school grounds must comply with all federal, state, and local laws.
3. All persons on school grounds must comply with all District policies, procedures, and school rules.
4. District property are Drug-Free Zones. The use or possession of illegal drugs (including marijuana), tobacco, and alcohol is prohibited. Possession by an adult (over the age of 21) of an unopened container of alcohol in a locked motor vehicle is not prohibited.
5. District property are Weapons-Free Zones. The use or possession of firearms or dangerous weapons is prohibited.
6. The use of unmanned aircraft systems (drones) is prohibited.
7. The use of any radio, audio speaker, musical instrument, record player, or any other machine or device producing or reproducing sound at a volume that is audible at a distance of 50 feet therefrom is prohibited.
8. Open fires, open flames, fireworks, and cigarettes are prohibited.
9. Overnight parking on school grounds is prohibited unless prior approved by the District facilities department.
