

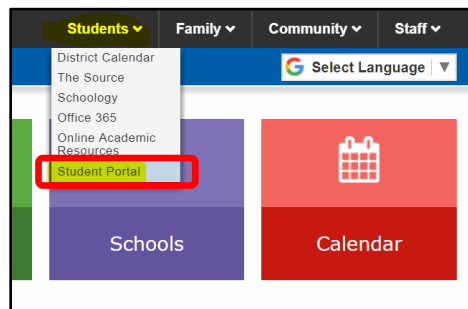
## How to Get to Schoology from Home

Schoology is Seattle Public Schools' learning management system, where teachers can communicate with students by posting assignments and resources, send messages, and more.

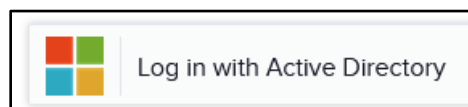
To access Schoology, students will need their **SPS username and password**, also known as their SPS Credentials. If you do not know your username and password, or have forgotten your password, please contact your classroom teacher.

### Follow these steps to access Schoology from home.

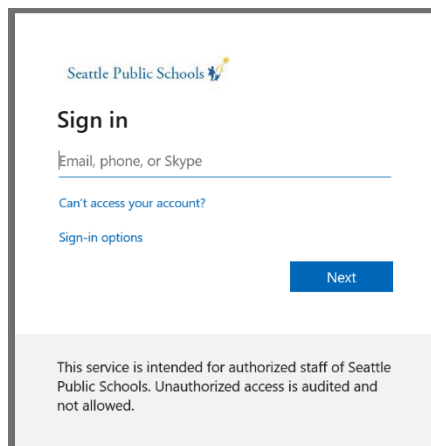
1. Open an internet browser like Chrome, Firefox or Safari and go to **[www.seattleschools.org](http://www.seattleschools.org)**.
2. From the **Students** pull-down menu, select **Student Portal**.



3. Click **Log in with Active Directory**.



4. Type your SPS username. Add **@seattleschools.org** onto your username when you sign in, so it looks like this: **[1YourUsername@seattleschools.org](mailto:1YourUsername@seattleschools.org)**. If you use the same device in the future, you will be able to select your account from a list.



## Accessing Schoology from Home

5. Type your SPS password in the password field.



6. Now you are in Clever, the Student Portal. Select the **Schoology** tile.



7. The home page for Schoology shows recent updates and calendar items. To view a specific class, click the Courses tab and select a class from the drop-down menu.
