

Addressing Incidents of  
Sexual Harassment/Sexual Assault  
(in Accordance with Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972)

- **Upon NOTICE...**
  - of sexual assault (unwanted, unconsented touching of a sexual nature); sexual violence; inappropriate touching (sexual nature or to sexual body parts); or child pornography, District protocol requires school administrator to notify/consult with District Title IX Coordinator
  
- **...the District must conduct a prompt, thorough, effective INVESTIGATION.**
  - May become a District level investigation based on the allegation and if there is collaboration with Seattle Police Department's Special Assault Unit
  
- During investigation, the District must implement **INTERIM SAFETY MEASURES** for students involved
  - School-based action planning with students, families. District-level representative may attend to support efforts.
  
- If found to be misconduct, then **IMPLEMENT CORRECTIVE ACTION** to eliminate the conduct, prevent recurrence, and remedy the effects
  - Ongoing collaboration between school and district staff regarding next steps to support students
