RESOLUTION 2016/17-6
CERTIFYING EXCESS LEVIES AND CALCULATION OF
GENERAL FUND LEVY ROLLBACK



A **RESOLUTION** by the Board of Directors of School District No. 1, King County, Washington, certifying collection of the 2017 Levy funds

WHEREAS, the State Legislature has limited the amount local school districts may raise through special levies, and

WHEREAS, the 2017 General Fund Operations Levy cannot exceed limitations imposed by RCW 84.52.0531, and any amount of such excess levy authorized by the voters must be reduced in accordance with that statute; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the King County Board of County Commissioners be requested to set the 2017 excess tax levy for the General Fund at a total of \$203,539,671, and to set the Capital Projects excess levy at \$195,033,333 as approved by the Board of Directors of the Seattle School District #1 in their meeting on November 16, 2016 and submitted to the King County Board of Commissioners. The final tax levy may be adjusted for Administrative Refunds of prior year levies as identified by King County.


