Opening New Schools

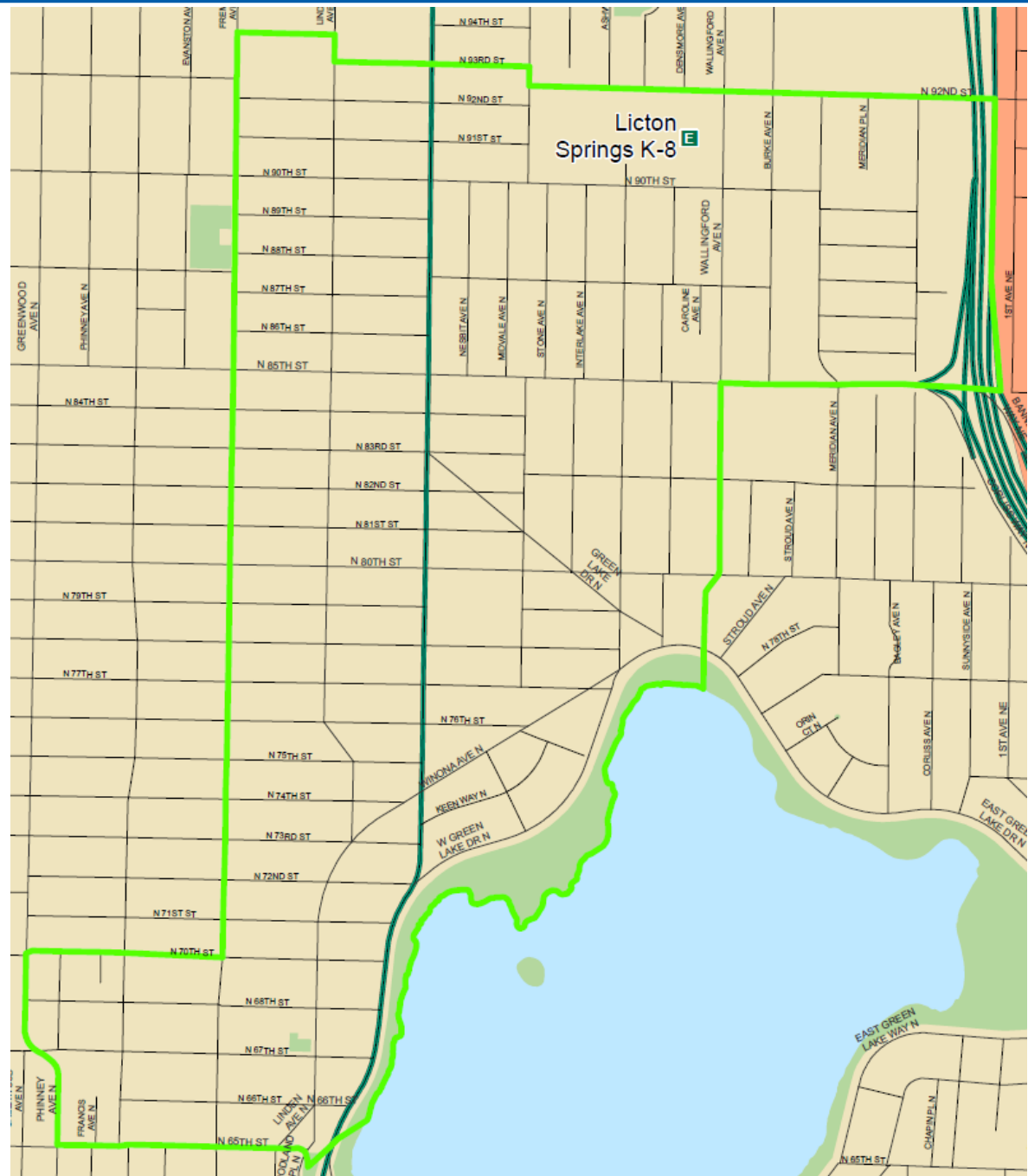
- Cedar Park Elementary
- Meany Middle
- Robert Eagle Staff Middle

Truncating Madrona K-8

- This school would **become a K-5**.
- Madrona is significantly under-enrolled in grades 6-8, resulting in staffing and scheduling challenges.
- Attendance area 6-8th grade students would be served at Meany, a comprehensive middle school.

Licton Springs K-8 GeoZone

The proposed GeoZone is designed to relieve capacity at **Daniel Bagley**.



Elementary School HCC Pathways

- **Cascadia** will move into its new building, but cannot accommodate all currently enrolled HCC students.
- Elementary school HCC students living in the Eckstein middle school attendance area would, beginning in 2017, attend **Decatur**.
- All other elementary school HCC pathways would remain the same.

Middle School HCC Pathways

- **Eagle Staff** will open as a new attendance area middle school, and will also offer HCC. Middle school HCC students living in the Eagle Staff and **Whitman** attendance areas would attend Eagle Staff.
- **Madison** is currently an option HCC site, and would become the default pathway school for HCC middle school students living in the **Denny** and Madison attendance areas.
- All other middle school HCC pathways would remain the same.

Dual Language Immersion Southeast Pathway

- Current dual language immersion students at **Mercer** International Middle School may:
 - Attend their attendance area high school, or
 - Continue in the dual language immersion program at **Chief Sealth** International High School, or
 - Apply for any another high school through Open Enrollment for School Choice.

New 6th-8th Graders

- New district 6th-8th grade students who live in **K-8 attendance areas** (Catharine Blaine and Broadview-Thomson) are currently assigned to their comprehensive middle school (McClure and Eagle Staff), but may request assignment to their K-8.
- Assigning new attendance area 6th-8th grade students to these K-8s would now be dependent on **space availability**.

Waitlist Dissolution Date

- Waitlists for the 2017-18 school year would dissolve on **August 31, 2017**.
- This will allow for additional school staff assignment processing and planning upon return from summer break.

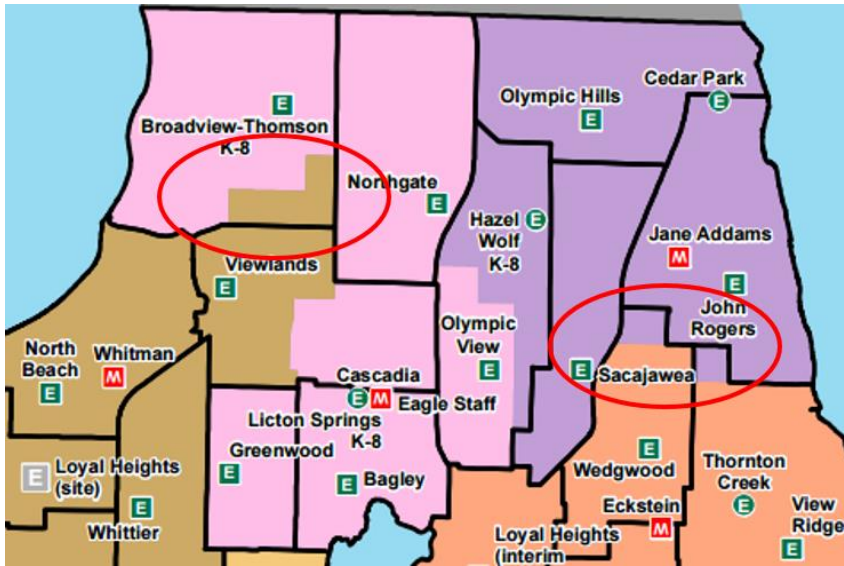
Nova High School

- Pilot as a service school for 2017-18 (currently an option school).
- This will allow greater access given that service schools do not follow the Open Enrollment timelines.

Elementary to Middle School Feeder Patterns

- As a result of the Growth Boundaries Board Action on Nov. 16, 2016, there are several elementary schools that feed into more than one attendance area middle school.
- Slightly realigning the **Eagle Staff** and **Eckstein** middle school attendance areas will allow cohorts from **View Ridge**, **Broadview-Thomson**, and **Wedgwood** to remain with their communities, in middle school.
