This annual report presents October 1, 2018 enrollment data. October 1 enrollment data is used for historical tracking, comparisons, calculation of enrollment projections and planning.

All data is reflective of the 2018-19 school boundaries. Boundary changes were implemented in 2018 for Genesee Hill, Lafayette, Adams, Loyal Heights and Whittier elementary schools. Both the Hutch School and the Early Learning Center closed at the end of the 2018 school year. More information on school boundary changes, also known as Growth Boundaries, including future year maps, project history and community meeting materials can be found on the Enrollment Planning Growth Boundaries webpage.



Section 2: Open Enrollment and School Choice Trends

Section 2 Notes: School Choice allows students to apply for a different school or program during an annual open enrollment period. A student may apply for any combination of attendance area or Option Schools.

Data for school choice applications is taken from on-time applications received during the first two weeks of the Open Enrollment period, usually in February.

Data does not include applications for guaranteed assignments, such as for HCC pathways.

2015-16 was the first year that STEM K-8 had a 6th grade cohort.

In the 2014 school year, John Stanford Intl and McDonald Intl became option schools.

Madrona was truncated to a K-5 school in 2017.

In 2018, all preschool students were under the Seattle Preschool Program.




