



Note: Central Admin and Fall Enrollment are recommended to be first, as these impact staffing positions.






BEX V: West Seattle Elementary Addition Project Timeline





BEX V: Rainier Beach High School Replacement Project Timeline




BEX V: Aki Kurose Middle School Design Only, Seismic, and Science Lab Project Timeline


