I. Call to Order

1. Roll Call

Director Hampson called the meeting to order at 12:02 p.m. Directors Hampson, Rankin, Hersey, and Rivera-Smith participated with Microsoft Teams or by phone.

2. Approval of agenda

II. Special Attention Item

1. 2021 Work Plan

Directors Hampson and Hersey opened the discussion about planning for the development of the academic and student well-being recovery plan for submission to the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OPSI) and other Board work to plan for the coming school year and beyond. Directors discussed prioritizing among ongoing Board work and aligning work streams in a timeline. Directors discussed the student outcomes focused governance framework and prioritizing meeting time to develop a shared vision consistent with the strategic plan and setting guardrails.

Directors and staff discussed currently scheduled work sessions and identifying opportunities to delay or cancel scheduled sessions. Directors discussed utilizing the March 31 meeting time to develop a shared vision. Directors discussed rescheduling or cancelling the Oversight Work Session scheduled for April 28.

Directors discussed engagement for the plan being submitted to OSPI. Directors and staff discussed district surveys. Directors and staff discussed holding May 6 for a potential Board Special Meeting, but working to incorporate that discussion into the May 5 Regular Board meeting.
