
Preface

The Annual Enrollment Report is provided to enable the Seattle Public Schools Board of Directors and community to follow the changes to enrollment, support the need of school boundary changes, and to provide data to inform decisions.

This annual report presents October 1, 2019 enrollment data. October 1 enrollment data is used for historical tracking, comparisons, calculation of enrollment projections and planning.

All data is reflective of the 2019-20 school boundaries. Two new schools opened in 2019: Lincoln High (9th and 10th grade only) and Magnolia Elementary. Because of these openings, boundary changes were implemented in 2019 for Ballard, Ingraham and Roosevelt high schools, and for Lawton and Catharine Blaine K-8 schools. Changes were also made to the boundaries of Jane Addams and Robert Eagle Staff middle schools to align Olympic View elementary school with the Jane Addams boundary. More information on school boundary changes, also known as Growth Boundaries, including future year maps, project history and community meeting materials can be found on the Enrollment Planning Growth Boundaries webpage.

Please note: prior to the 2016-17 school year, Genesee Hill Elementary School was known as Schmitz Park. In 2019, Van Asselt elementary had a name change to Rising Star.













