1. TITLE

Elevator Maintenance and Repair Contract Extension

2. PURPOSE

This Board Action Report extends the elevator maintenance and repair contract with ELTEC for the 2017-18 School Year.

3. <u>RECOMMENDED MOTION</u>

I move that the School Board authorize the Superintendent to execute the elevator maintenance and repair contract with ELTEC in the amount of \$284,200, to ensure elevator maintenance and repairs to the District, as attached to the School Board Action Report, with any minor additions, deletions, and modifications deemed necessary by the Superintendent, and to take any necessary actions to implement the contract.

4. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

This contract is for routine maintenance of all elevators in the District and repairs as needed. The State master contract, which was scheduled to expire on September 30, 2017, has been extended. This allows the District to renew for at least an additional 12 months with ELTEC through the State master contract. This contract represents a 16% increase over the previous year due to the increase in the number of schools needing elevator maintenance. There are no viable alternatives to having an elevator maintenance contract in place.

SEATTLE PUBLIC SCHOOLS AMENDMENT NO. 3 MASTER STATE CONTRACT NO. 00713 ELEVATOR MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR



THIS AMENDMENT is made between the Seattle School District No. 1, (hereinafter called "District"), and ELTEC SYSTEMS, LLC (hereinafter called "Vendor") regarding Master State Contract 00713 for Elevator Maintenance and Repair;

Whereas, the District and the Vendor entered into a contract dated November 20, 2014; and later amended on November 5, 2015, and August 23, 2016 herein incorporated by this reference; and,

Whereas, the District's contract with the Vendor allows for renewals through the term of the State Contract and the District wishes to renew and extend the term of their contact through the term of the current State Contract, which expires September 30, 2018; and

Whereas, due to the increase in the number of schools needing elevator maintenance in the 2017-2018 school year, the District and Vendor wish to increase the contract amount by sixteen percent (16%) of the previous contract amount of \$245,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, District and Vendor agree as follows:

- 1. Extension Term. The term of the contract is extended from October 1, 2017 to September 30, 2018.
- 2. <u>Contract Amount</u>. The total contract amount for this Extension Term shall not exceed **TWO HUNDRED EIGHTY-FOUR THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS** (\$284,200.00).
- 3. Any of the other provisions of the subject contract not modified in writing shall remain in full force and effect.
