## VI. BOARD COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

This motion was discussed at the Operations Committee meeting on August 16, 2016. The Committee moved this item forward to the full Board with a recommendation for approval.

#### VII. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Playfield Renovations at View Ridge Elementary School project provided a new playfield drainage system for the field, a new backstop, dugouts, fencing, and improved ADA access by constructing a concrete ramp connecting the upper playground to the lower playfield.

The Contractor, A-1 Landscaping and Construction, Inc., has satisfactorily completed the contracted work and the consulting Landscape Architect, D.A. Hogan & Associates, Inc., is in agreement and recommends acceptance of the completed work. All closeout documents have been obtained and there are no outstanding claims.

## VIII. STATEMENT OF ISSUE

Approval of this motion will allow the District to formally accept the work and close out the contract.

#### IX. ALTERNATIVES

Not accepting the project in a timely manner could put the District in a position subject to litigation. Therefore, this alternative is not recommended.
