Portable Management: Recent History

Background

- Current portable count: 287
- Board requested detailed plan to include:
 - Portables being demolished, relocated/refurbished that are driven by construction
 - 2018 McKinistry Portables Scores
 - Outlined funding for BEX IV/BTA IV, BEX V and continuous development for BTA V
 - Portables that are necessary for capacity and non-capacity needs including: demolishing, refurbishing, or replacing current portables

McKinistry Condition Assessment

Scored condition of each portable based on the OSPI criteria by using a percentage rating 0%–100%

- 91-100% Excellent (Preventative Maintenance)
- 63-90% Good (Routine Maintenance)
- 31-62% Fair (Minor Repairs)
- 1-30% Poor (Major Repairs)
- 0% Unsatisfactory condition (Replacement)
- N/A Not evaluated by McKinistry/to be evaluated by staff

Budget Per Portable Classroom

Budget per Portable Classroom = \$180,000 based on 2018/19 \$

Based on "average" estimate per classroom as follows:

\$13,000 Curriculum

\$13,640 Technology

\$22,000 Furniture

\$130,000 Portables Relocation/Procurement and Complete Install

\$20,000 Demolish

\$40,000 Refurbish

\$172,000 Demolish/Replace/Furniture





Portable Action Plan

Goal: All portables with a McKinistry Condition Assessment scoring lower than 60.00, demolished or refurbished/replaced by end of Fiscal Year 2025/26

- Priority list for relocating, demolishing or refurbishing/replacing based on:
 - Sites undergoing construction
 - Interim site needs
 - Portables that do not have labels and have oil tanks
 - The McKinistry Condition Assessment scoring lower than 60.00
- Efforts made to direct demolished materials from landfill facilities
 - Waste Diversion Report for each portables demolition project
