
Math Enrollment 5th Grade to 6th Grade Transition Seattle Public Schools | 2022-2023

Guidance

Students in Seattle Public Schools enroll in their next course in sequence. Thus, students transitioning from Grade 5 Math to 6th grade will be enrolled into Math 6.

Secondary Math Career Options


All students can access advanced math coursework (Advanced Placement Statistics, International Baccalaureate Standard Level math (IB SL), or College in the High School math courses) by their senior year. Students will also have the opportunity to accelerate one year in math in middle or high school to reach additional advanced math coursework (Advanced Placement Calculus or International Baccalaureate Higher Level math (IB HL)) IF it aligns with their high school and beyond goals.
