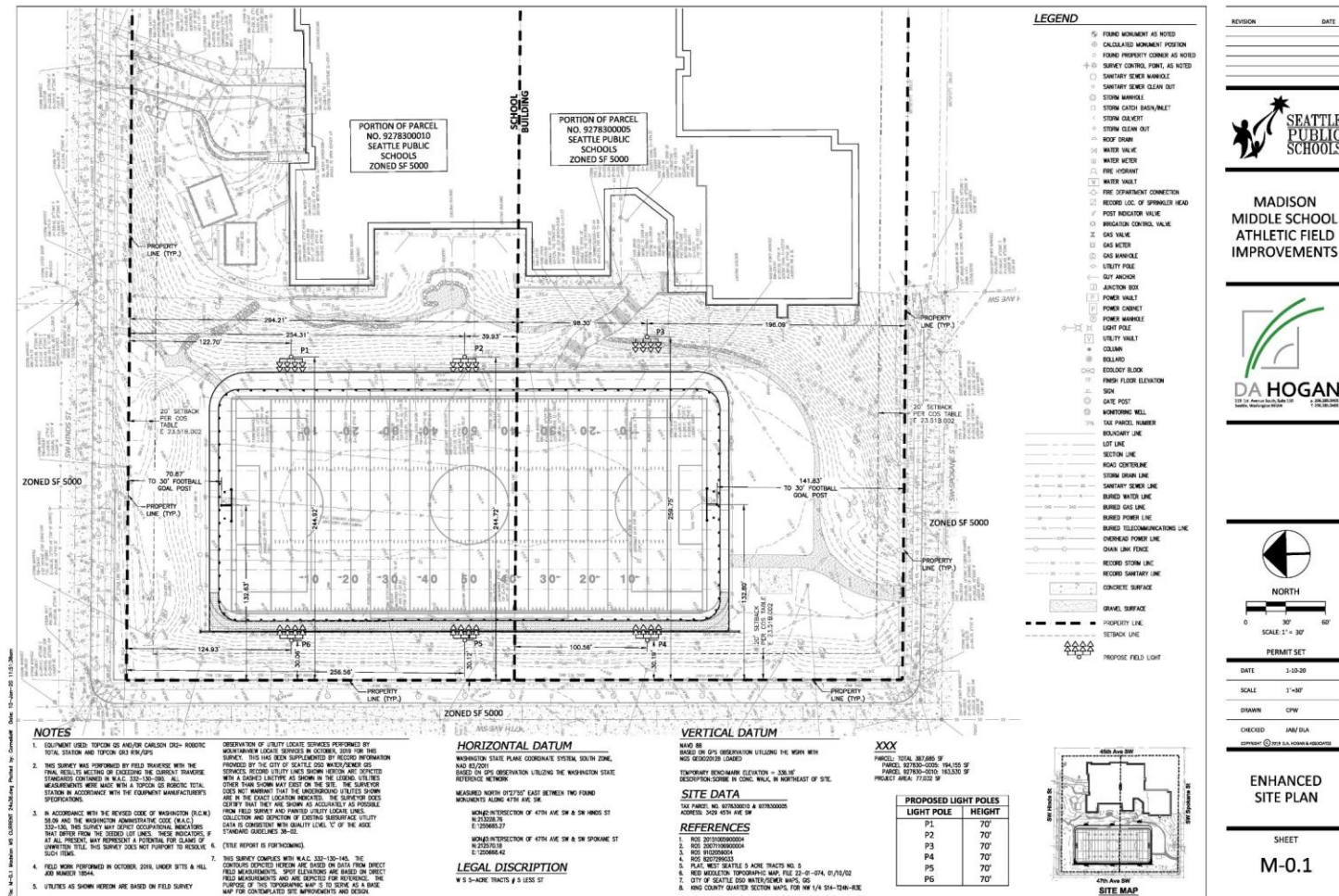

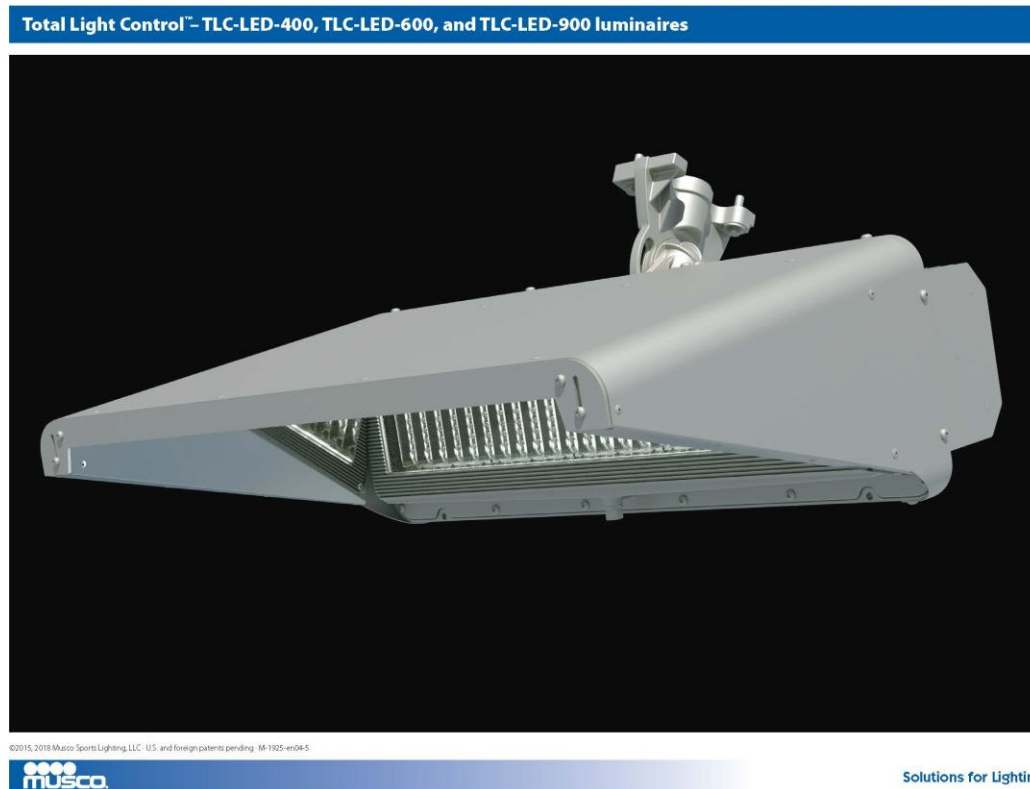

Lighting Plan

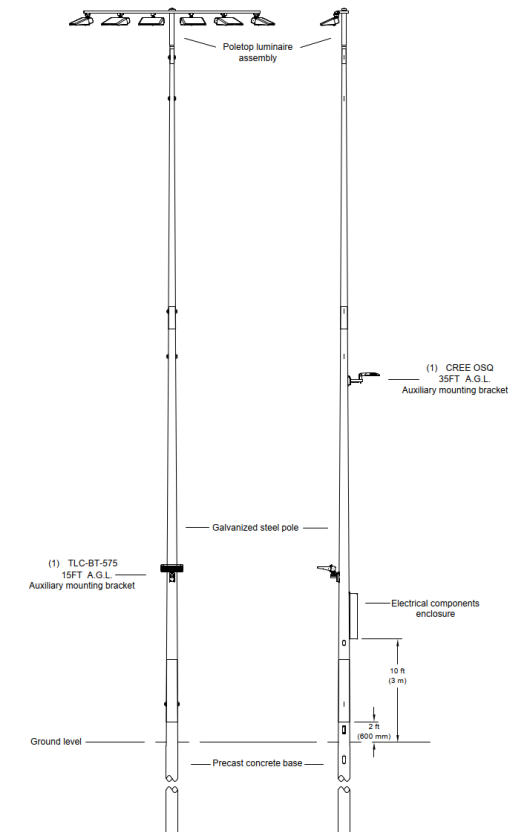


Lighting Overview

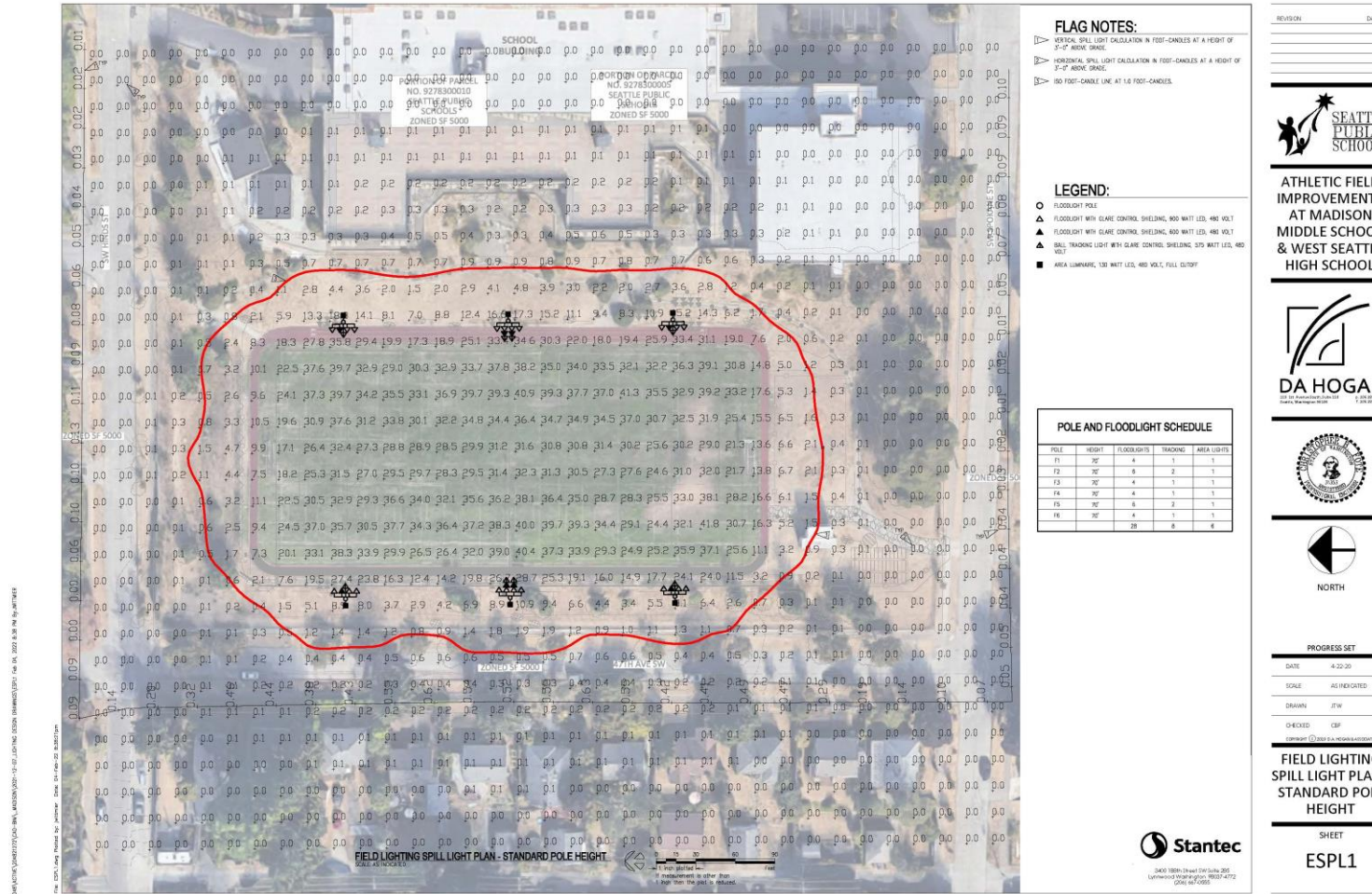
Proposed Shielded Floodlight

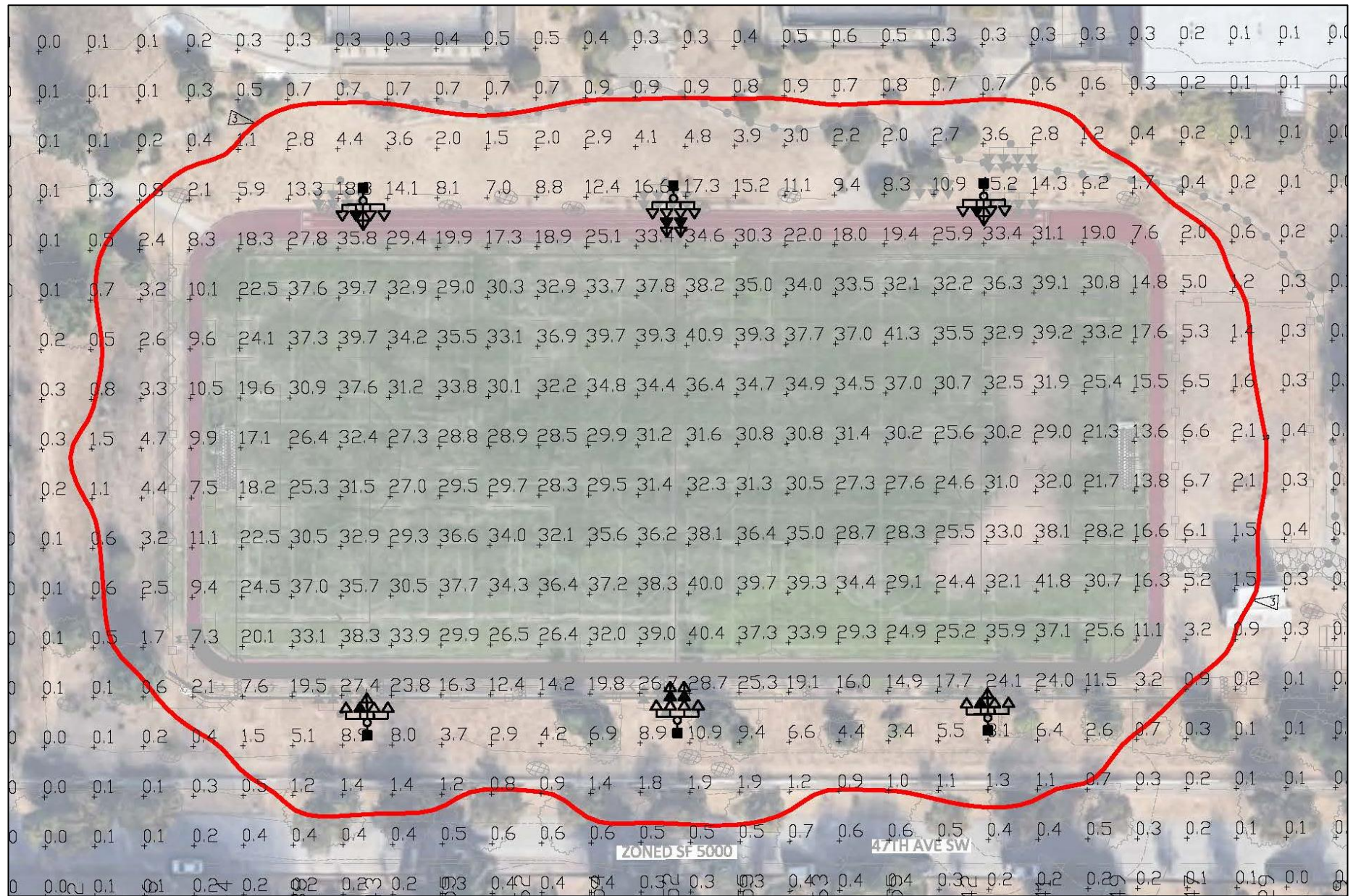


LED Floodlights & Pole



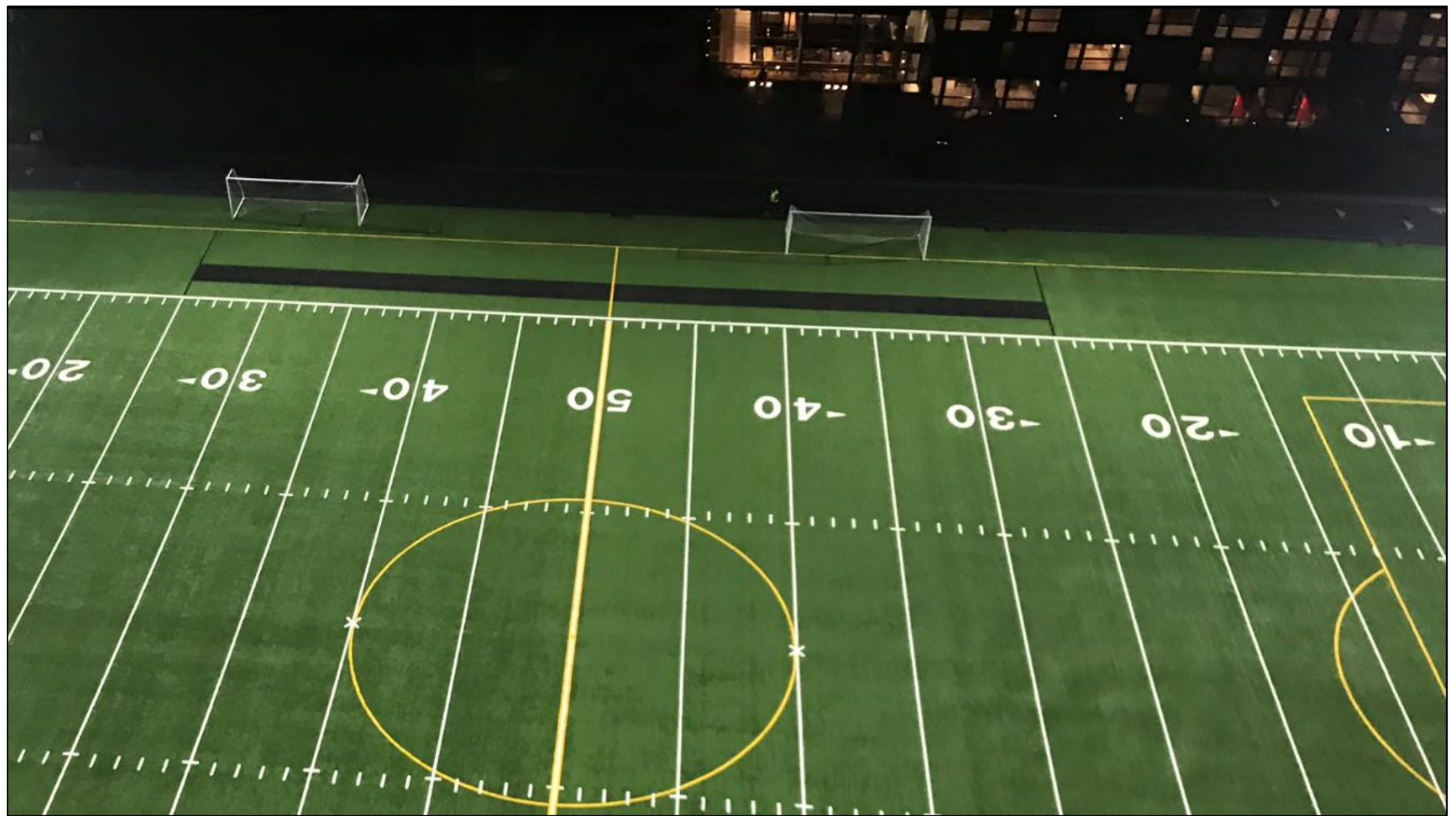
Spill Light Plan

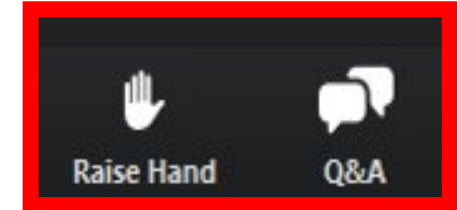
