ChatGPT 3.5

PE Heart Monitors

Mr. Del Valle discussed PE Heart Monitors by discussing Policy No. 2185, the benefits of heart monitor technology, equipment/devices, and implementation. There will be an assessment of Cyber Security concerns, and FP and a rollout with initial emphasis on the 13 schools of promise. The funding for this is programmed under BTA IV.

Paul asked if we will be able to see what steps will be taken for daily privacy concerns. April responded that we have very tight data sharing agreements with vendors. They've considered using initials and other methods to protect student data.

Program Manager for Physical Education & Health Literacy Lori Dunn followed up stating they've been using Wellnet software that houses all the fitness data and they have a user agreement with Focus Fitness that also houses data.

Craig asked if the teachers are taking on additional responsibilities with this technology in the classroom. Lori responded hopefully it's the student observing and managing their health changes using the technology.

Robert asked is there a mechanism for students to take their data after they finish school at SPS. Lori responded the data has been housed in Wellnet and is there.

Jian asked if the information is considered protected health information. Mr. Del Valle responded the private data concerns will be written within the RFP.
