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The Advanced Learning 2022 Parent Survey Report is based upon total of 15210 submissions. Of those, 5367 were completed and used for the report.

Surveys visually depicted the percentages of parent responses by:

- Region of school the student attended (NW region submitted the most surveys)
- Grade level (Students in lower grade levels had more submissions)
- SOCFEJ in each region (Families FFEJ averaged 12.3% of submissions)
- Racial Category (White student responses outweighed other race categories)

Other questions considered on the survey were based upon Hopes and Dreams, Hobbies, Influences, Mentor, and Storytelling.

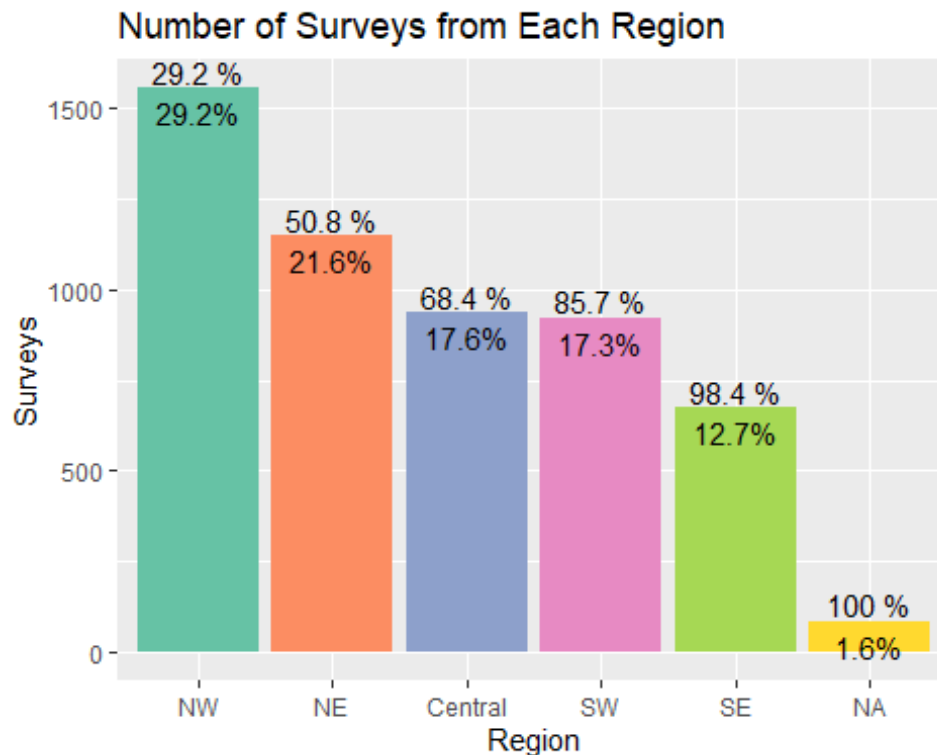

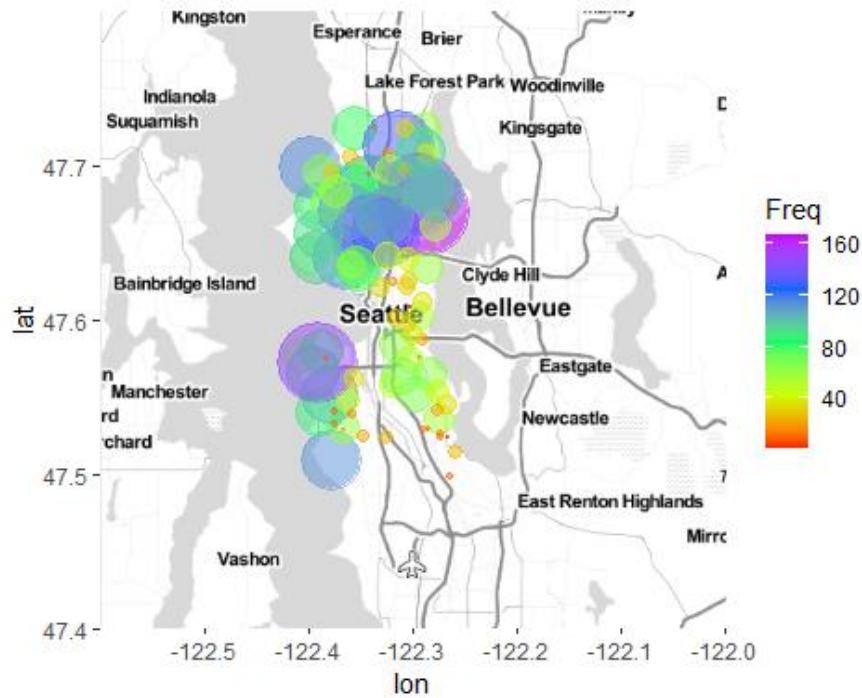
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This year, families submitted a total of 15210 parent surveys. Of those, 5367 surveys were complete and were used for this report.

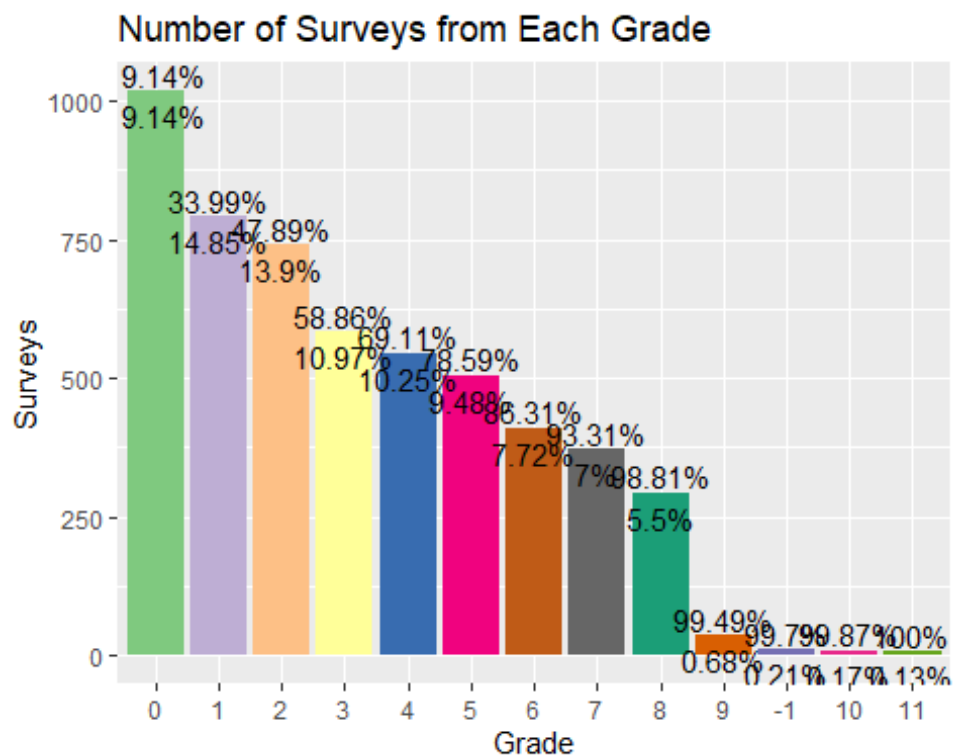
Families with students attending in the NW region of the district submitted the most surveys with 1556 which constitutes 29.2% of the completed surveys. Below, is depicted the numbers of surveys submitted by region of school the student attends. The percentage within the bar denotes the percent of total completed surveys are from that region and the percentage above the bar denotes the added percent of surveys completed by the regions and all the regions previously listed.



The same information above can be demonstrated by the regions on a map. Each circle on the map represents a school. The size and color of that circle represents the number of surveys submitted by families at the school. While it is harder to distinguish each region, the difference in survey submissions between the north and south regions can be clearly seen.



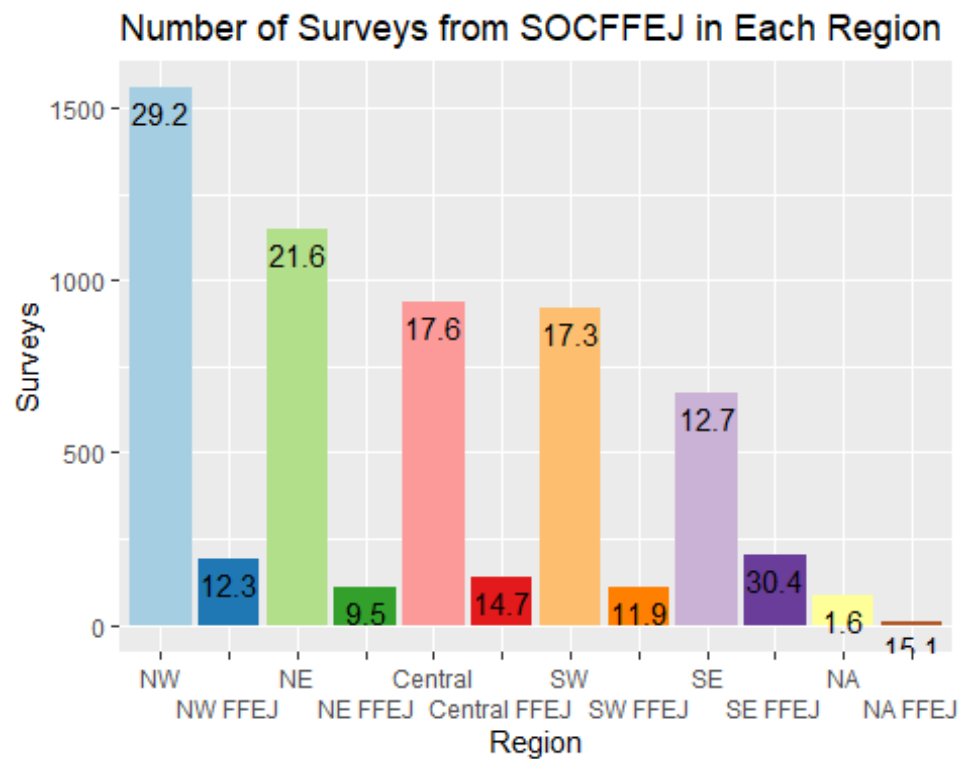
There were also differences in survey submissions according to grade level of the student. In general, the students with lower grade numbers had more submissions and as the grade level increased, the number of surveys submitted decreased.



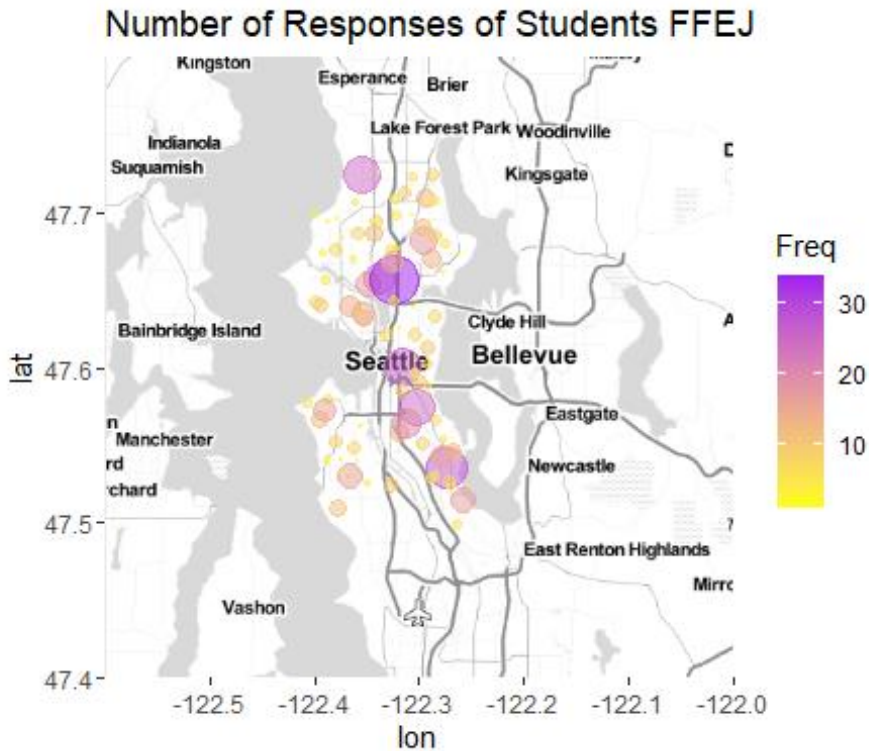
SOCFFEJ

From the total of 5367 survey responses, 767 were from students furthest from educational justice. That is 14.4% of total responses that are from families with SOCFFEJ. We can compare that with the percentages of SOCFFEJ responses in each region.

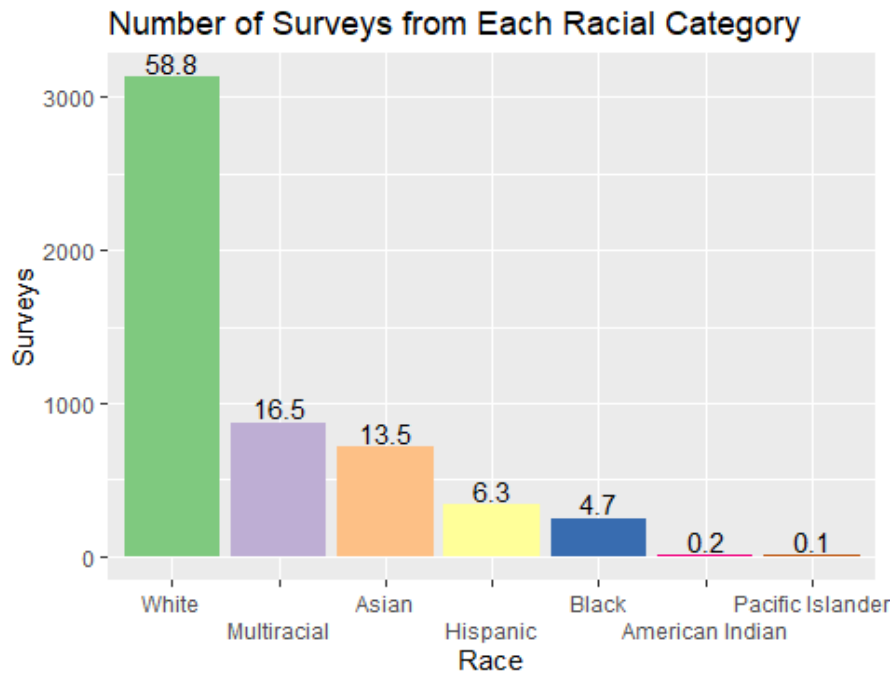
The bars labelled FFEJ show the number of surveys submitted from families the with SOCFFEJ within that region. For example, we can see that out of the 1556 submissions from NW region, 192 were for SOCFFEJ which is 12.3% of the submissions from that region.



This information can also be seen on a map of the school district. Below, the number of surveys submitted by families with SOCFFEJ is represented.



Out of the survey responses, responses submitted for white students outweighed other race categories. 58.8% were submitted for white students. Followed by 16.5% submitted for multiracial students, 13.5% for Asian students, 6.3% for Hispanic students, 4.7% for black students, 0.2% for American Indian students, and 0.1% for pacific islander students.

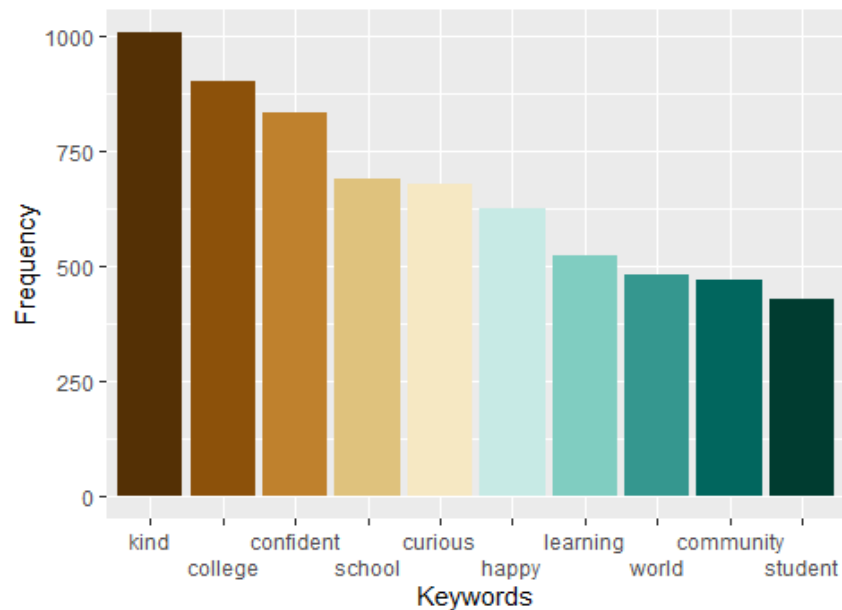


Keywords from Parent Survey

The top 10 relevant words in the answers for questions about the student are depicted in the bar graphs and the top 30 relevant words are depicted in word clouds.

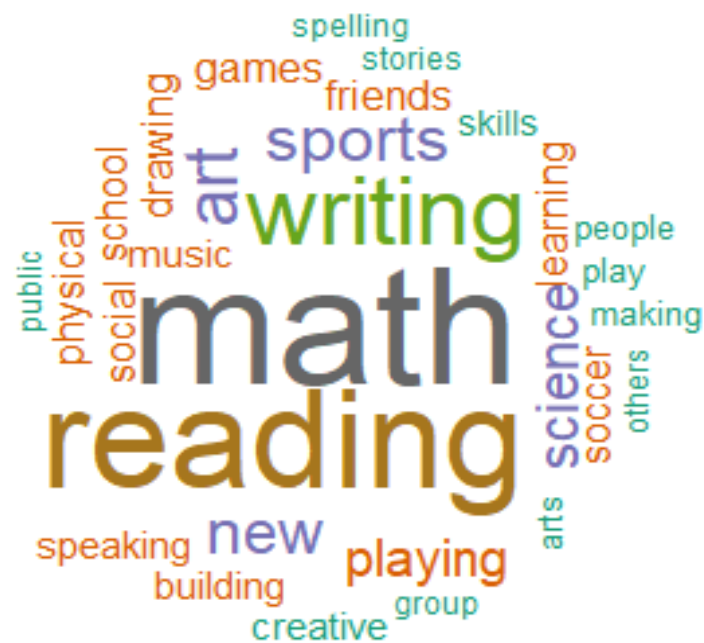
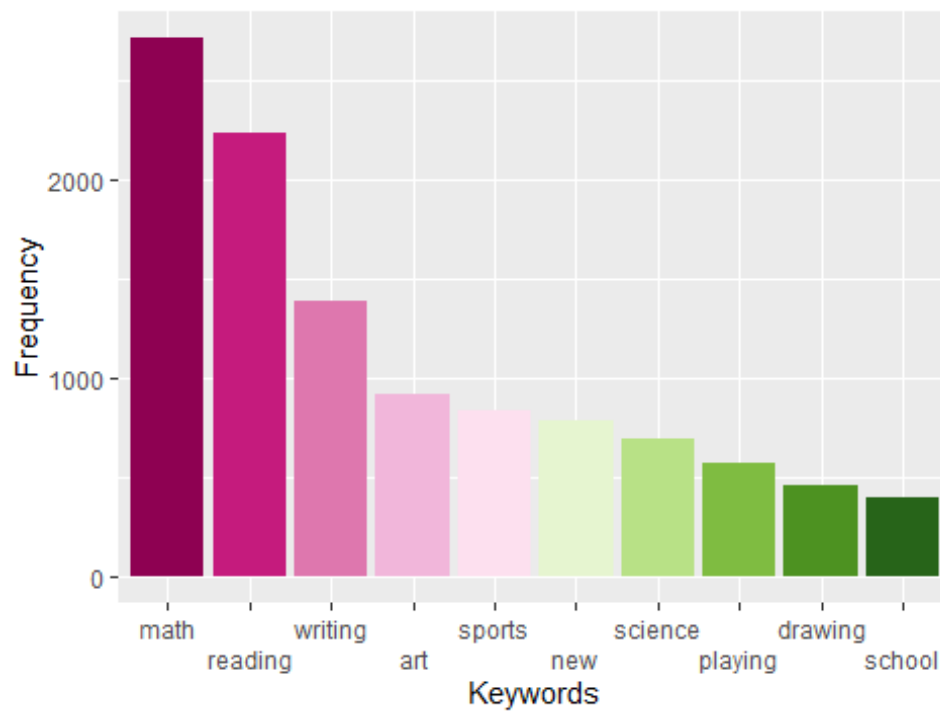

How do you envision your student's life in 10 years?



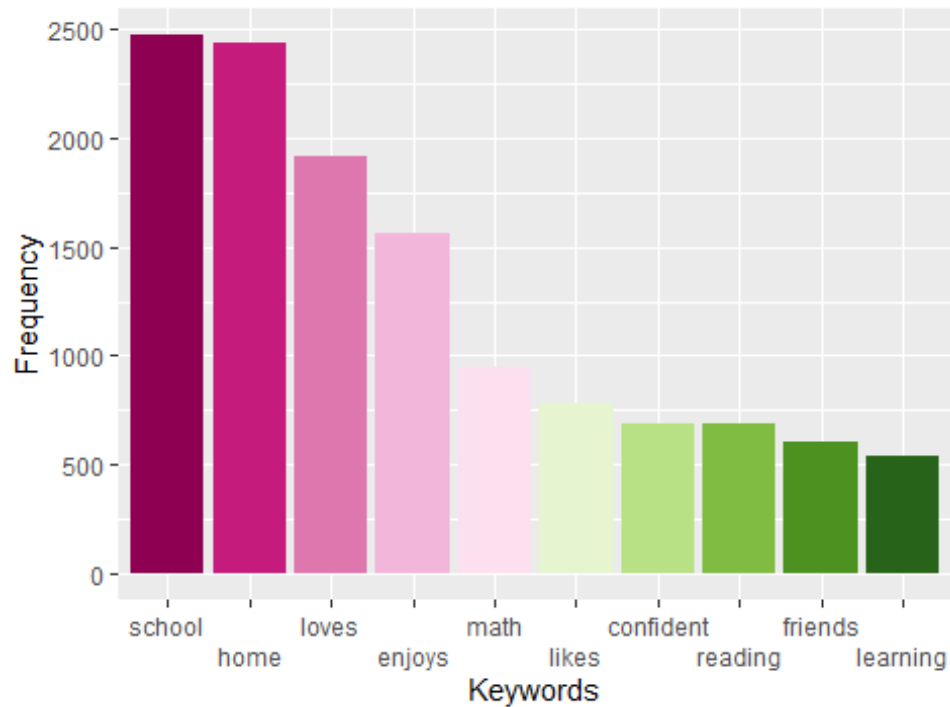
Hobbies

What activities does your student find most interesting?



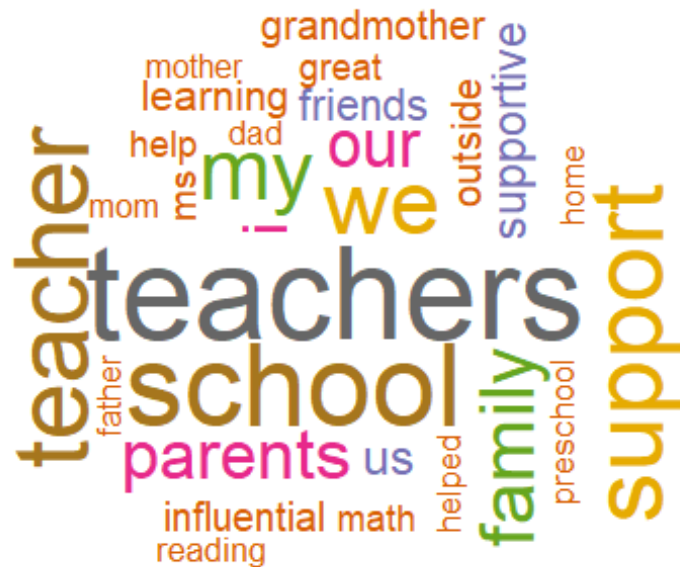
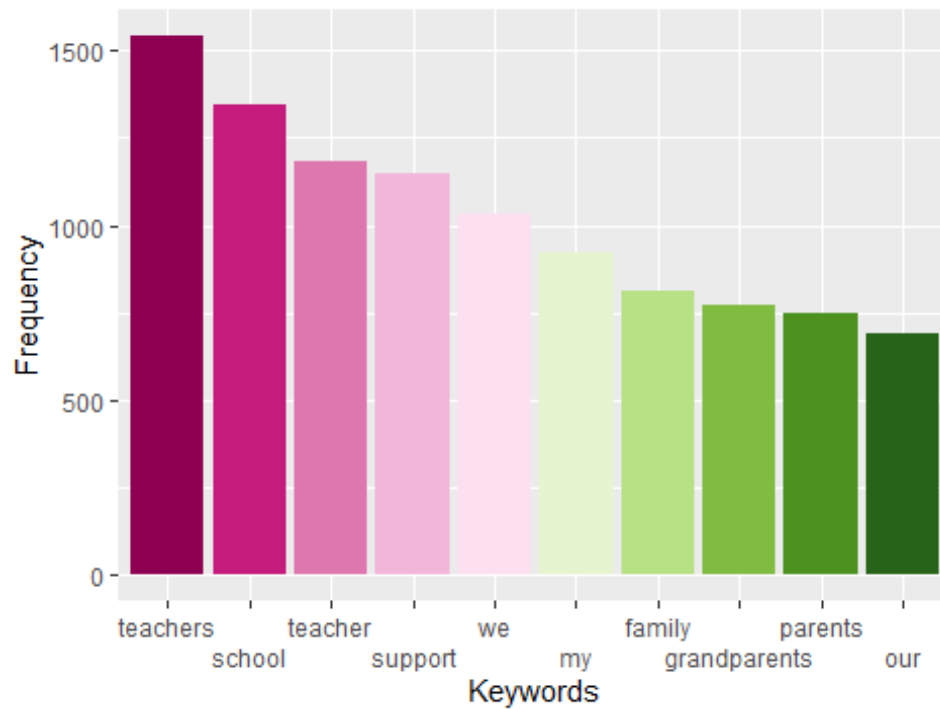

Where does your student do this activity most or why do you believe they love it?



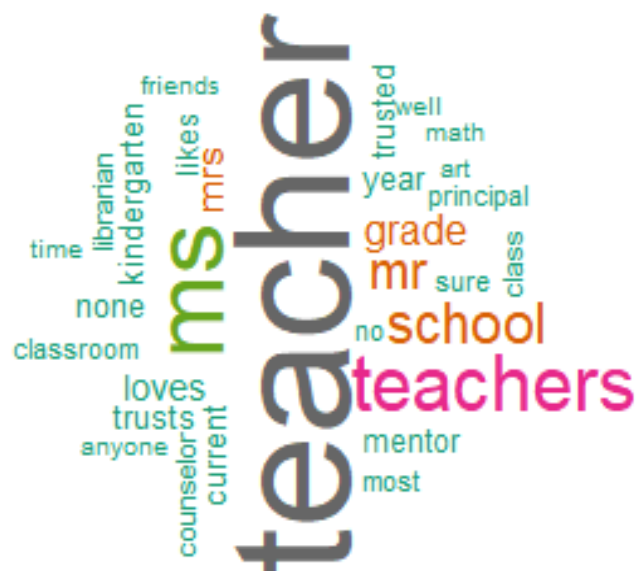
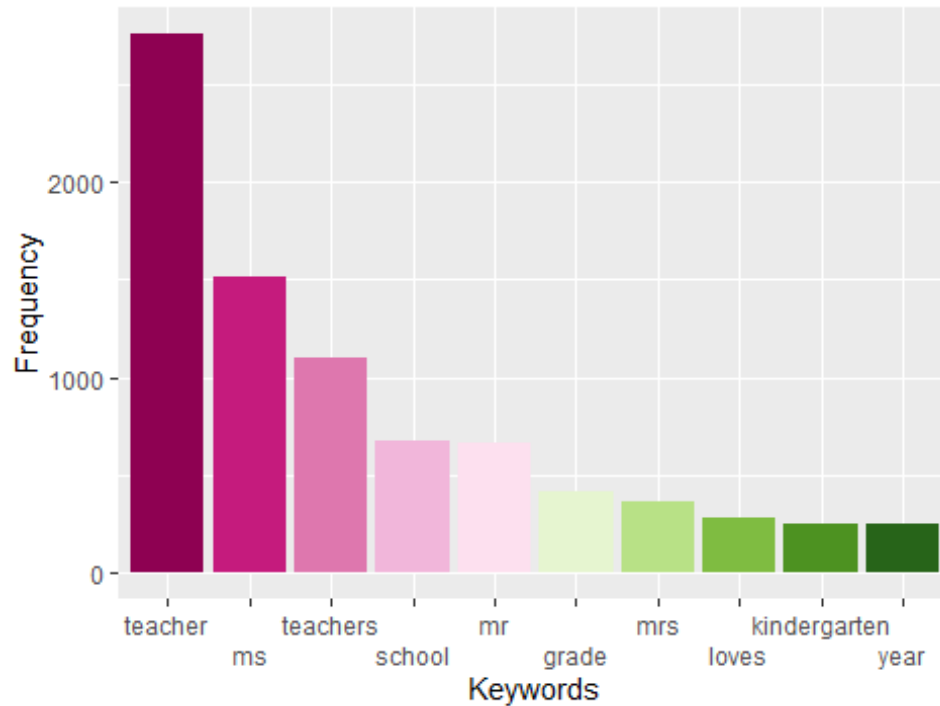
