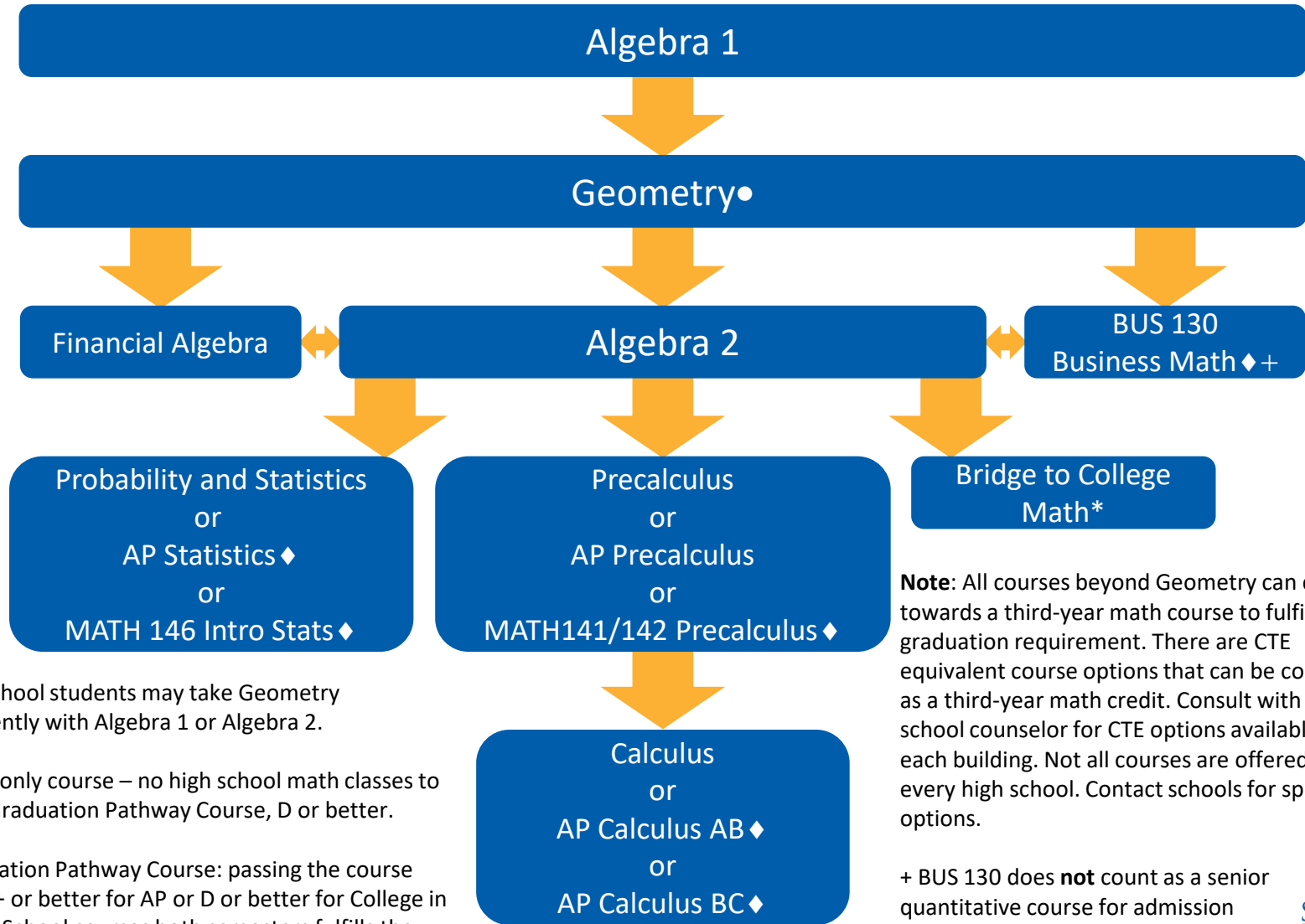


# Math Pathways | AP



• High school students may take Geometry concurrently with Algebra 1 or Algebra 2.

\* Senior only course – no high school math classes to follow. Graduation Pathway Course, D or better.

◆ Graduation Pathway Course: passing the course with a C+ or better for AP or D or better for College in the High School courses both semesters fulfills the math component of the graduation requirements.

**Note:** All courses beyond Geometry can count towards a third-year math course to fulfill the graduation requirement. There are CTE equivalent course options that can be counted as a third-year math credit. Consult with a school counselor for CTE options available in each building. Not all courses are offered at every high school. Contact schools for specific options.

+ BUS 130 does **not** count as a senior quantitative course for admission to Washington state universities.
