Middle School Students Taking Out-of-District High School Courses - SPS Form

If you are a middle school student who has completed or intends to complete a high school course before attending high school, we ask you to complete and submit this form to your school staff before you start high school to inform their scheduling.

Please note that per state guidelines a "high school course" means that either (1) The course was taken with high school students, if the academic level of the course exceeds the requirements for seventh and eighth grade classes, and the student has successfully passed by completing the same course requirements and examinations as the high school students enrolled in the class; or (2) The academic level of the course exceeds the requirements for seventh and eighth grade classes and the course would qualify for high school credit, because the course is similar or equivalent to a course offered at a high school in the district as determined by the school district board of directors. If you are seeking credit for an SPS-equivalent course, the provider must affirm that their course aligns to the specific content of the SPS-provided equivalent course for which they are offering credit using this form. They can review the content of SPS courses on the district's Academics page. The course provider should provide you and your school with a copy of the transcript upon successful completion of the course.
