### Seattle School District #1 Financial Statements May 2025

The May 2025 monthly financial report is provided as required by Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 392-123-110.

#### **Fund Balance Summary**

#### **General Fund**

- For fiscal year May 2025, the ending fund balance is \$61.2 Million(M). This compares to \$88.4M for May 2024. Fund balance fluctuates during the year due to how the district collects and expends funds. Overall, fund balance will continue to decrease this fiscal year as total expenditures exceed total revenue.
- May enrollment of 48,571 is 879 more than adopted budget for FY25 and 6 less than the same enrollment period of last school year. Enrollment typically increases each month throughout the school year (see Pg. 3).
- Revenues are \$820M YTD, compared to \$783.8M last year (see Pg. 5). Revenue increases over last year are due to an increase in state funding and a decrease of federal funding to date, for an overall increase in revenue of 4.4%.
- Expenditures of \$900.7M are up by \$71.1M over the previous year (see Pg. 5). Salaries and benefits, special education, and transportation costs are contributing factors, for an overall increase in expenditures of 7.9%.

#### **Capital Projects Fund**

- The Capital Projects Fund balance is \$290M compared to \$433.7M in the prior year. Fund balance is comprised primarily of BEX V \$90.2M, BEX IV \$29.6M, BTA IV \$28.6M, and BTA V \$98.6M levies.
- Revenues are \$353M, consisting primarily of property tax earnings from the BEX V \$230.5M and BTA V \$118.3M.
- Expenditures of \$257.4M are comprised principally of BEX V \$190M, and BTA V \$55.1M (see Pg. 11).

#### **Debt Service Fund**

May 2025 fund balance is \$1.5M. Fund balance is restricted for payments of the principal and interest related to the 2020 refunding bond (see Pg. 9c). The amount owed on the 2020 refunding bond is

\$6.7M. Annual principal payments are made on December 1, while semi-annual interest payments are made on December 1 and June 1, funded by the Capital Projects Fund. Annual principal and interest payments will continue until the final payment is made on December 1, 2026 (see page 13).

#### **Associated Student Body**

- The Associated Student Body Funds represent monies raised by student groups for cultural, athletic, recreational, and/or social purposes. Fund balance at the close of May 2025 is \$4.7M compared to \$4.6M last year (see Pg. 9d).
- YTD Revenue is \$4.8M.
- YTD Expenditures are \$4M.

#### Private/Trust

The Trust Fund accounts are monies donated to the district for private purposes, primarily student scholarships for post-secondary education, and are governed by individual trust agreements. Fund balance at the close of May 2025 is \$2.6M compared to \$2.5M as of May 2024.

#### **Cash and Investments**

- Cash flow balances continue to be strong for all funds. However, as fund balance continues to decline in the general fund, cash will also decline and will need to be monitored closely. General fund cash less warrants outstanding at the close of May 2025 is \$171.9M compared to \$163.3M in May 2024 (see page 9a).
- The King County Pool net earned interest rate was 4.46% in April, compared to 4.20% of the previous year (see Pg. 10). (May rates were not available at time of printing)

#### **Head Start Program Budget to Actual Expenditures**

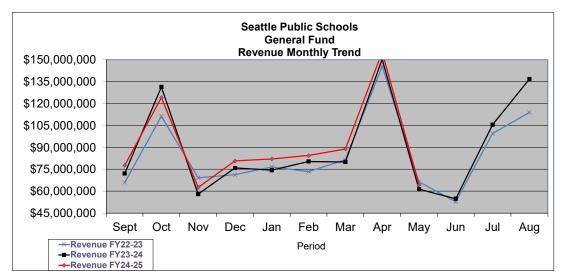
The Head Start grant is a federal program awarded to the district by the Health and Human Services Division. Head Start Program performance standards require a financial status report be presented on at least a semi-annual basis. The Head Start grant crosses the district fiscal year as the grant award period is February 1<sup>st</sup> through October 31<sup>st</sup>. Year to Date expenditures at the close of May 2025 is \$3.3M (see page 14).

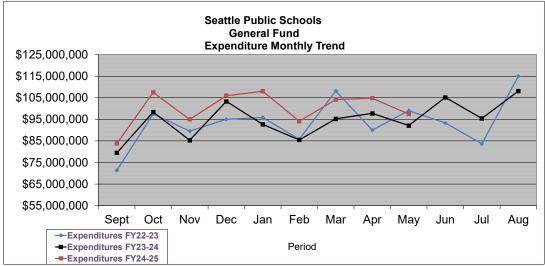
#### **Seattle School District** Average Annual Enrollment by Grade As of 05/31/2025

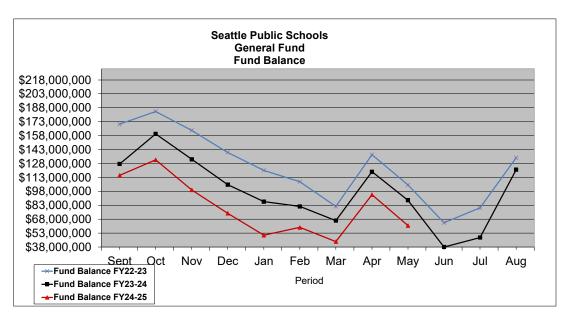
