

SchoolLinks – High School and Beyond Plan (Grades 6–12)

Seattle Public Schools has launched SchoolLinks, Washington state's new High School and Beyond Plan (HSBP) platform. Students in grades 6–12 will use SchoolLinks to complete their HSBP, a Washington state graduation requirement that helps students explore interests, set goals, and plan for life after high school.

What families need to know:

- Student access begins September 2, 2026.
- SchoolLinks replaces Naviance as the district's college and career readiness platform.
- Students can use SchoolLinks to explore careers, colleges, apprenticeships, training programs, and other postsecondary pathways.
- Students will update their High School and Beyond Plan each year and track progress toward their educational and career goals.
- Students access SchoolLinks using their Seattle Public Schools account through Clever. For student directions on how to login, visit [Clever Student Portal](#).
- Families will receive information about creating a parent/guardian account after students have accessed the platform.
- Parent/guardian accounts will allow families to view their student's HSBP progress and explore college and career options together.
- Students will receive support through classroom lessons, school counselors, and online resources throughout the school year.
