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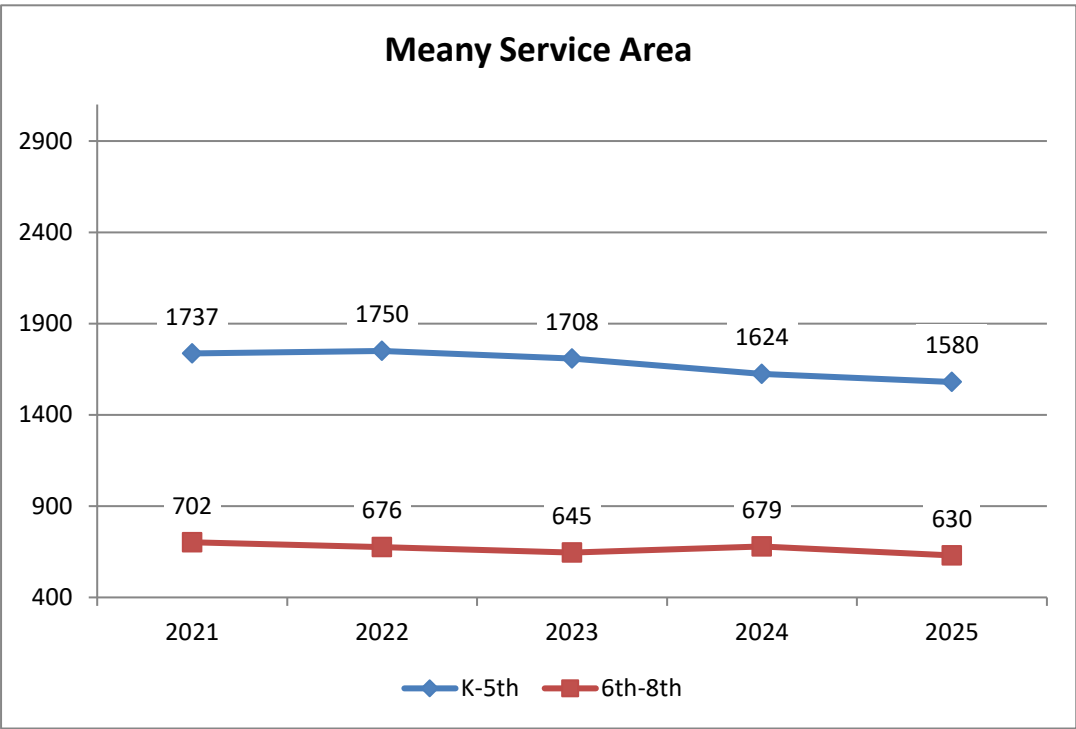
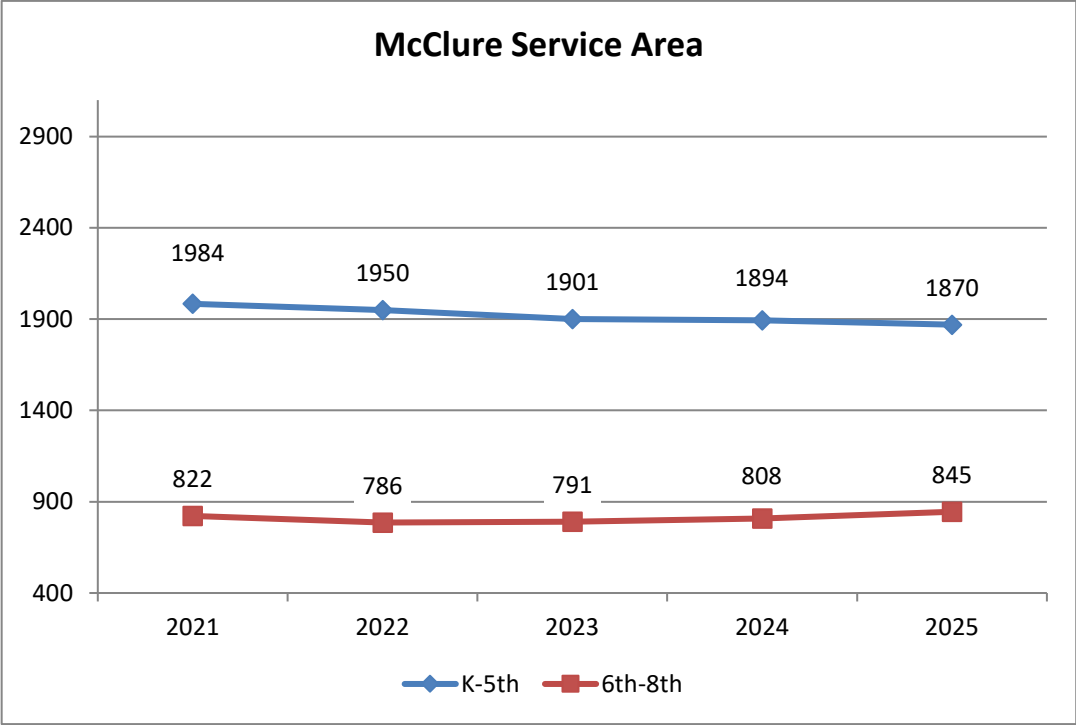
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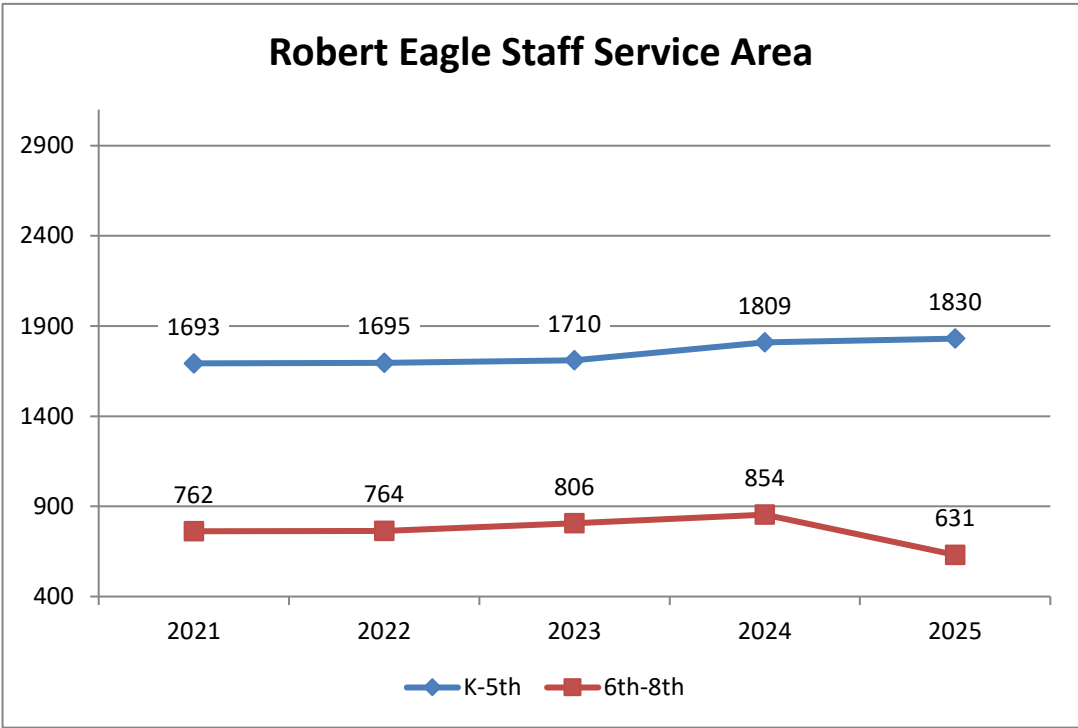
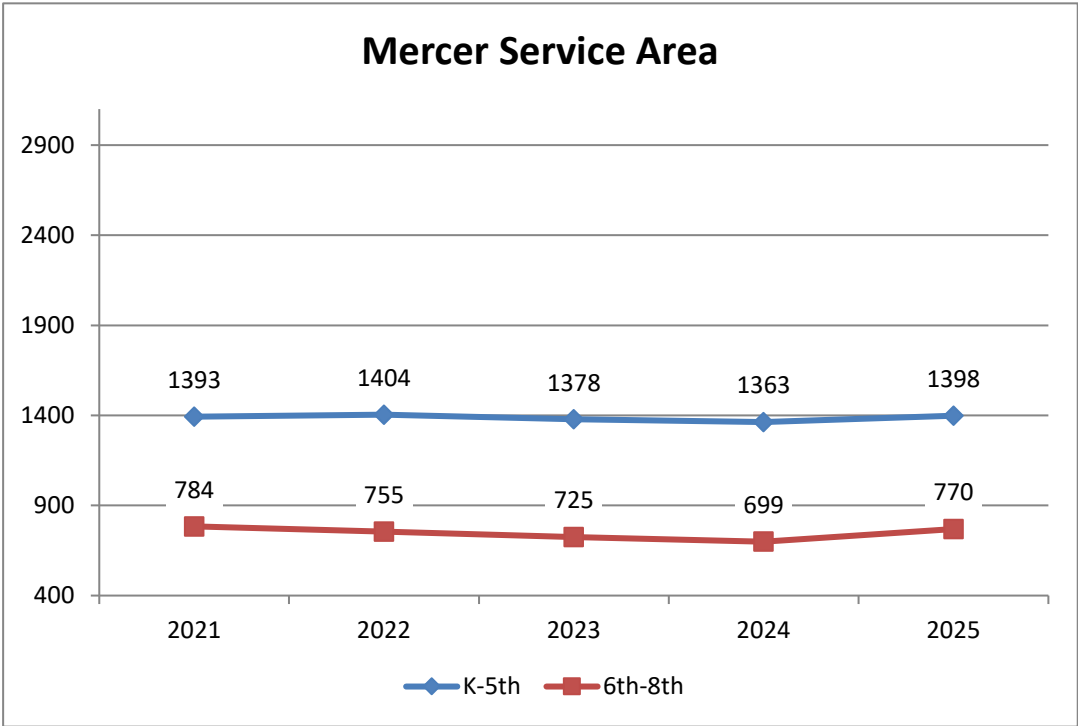
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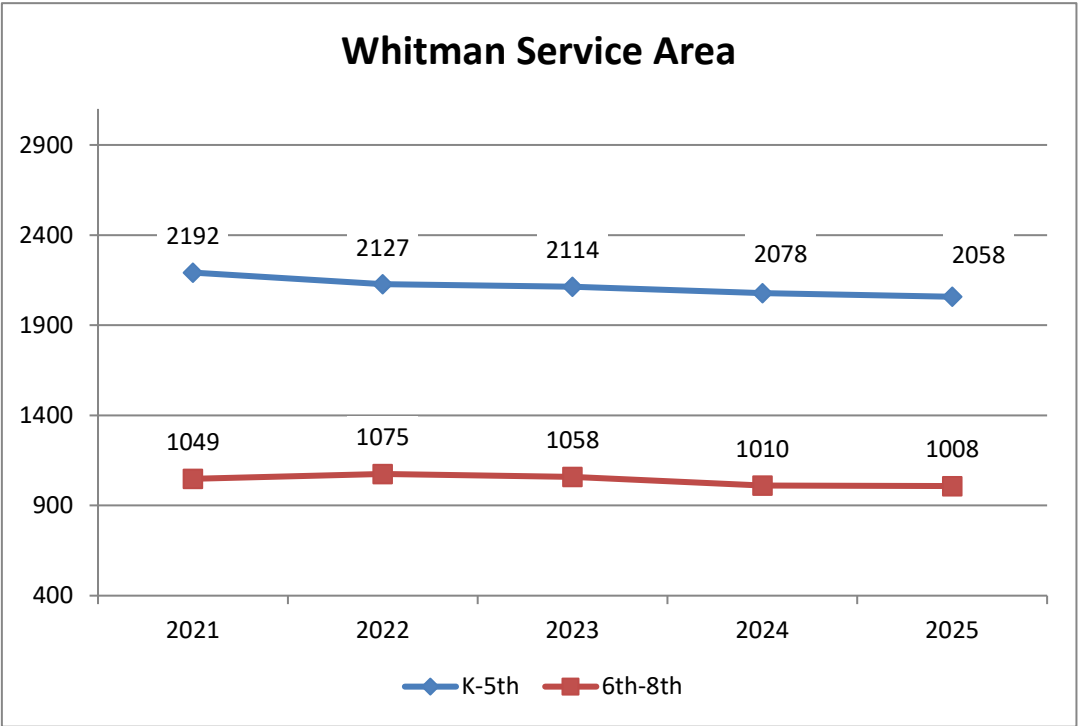
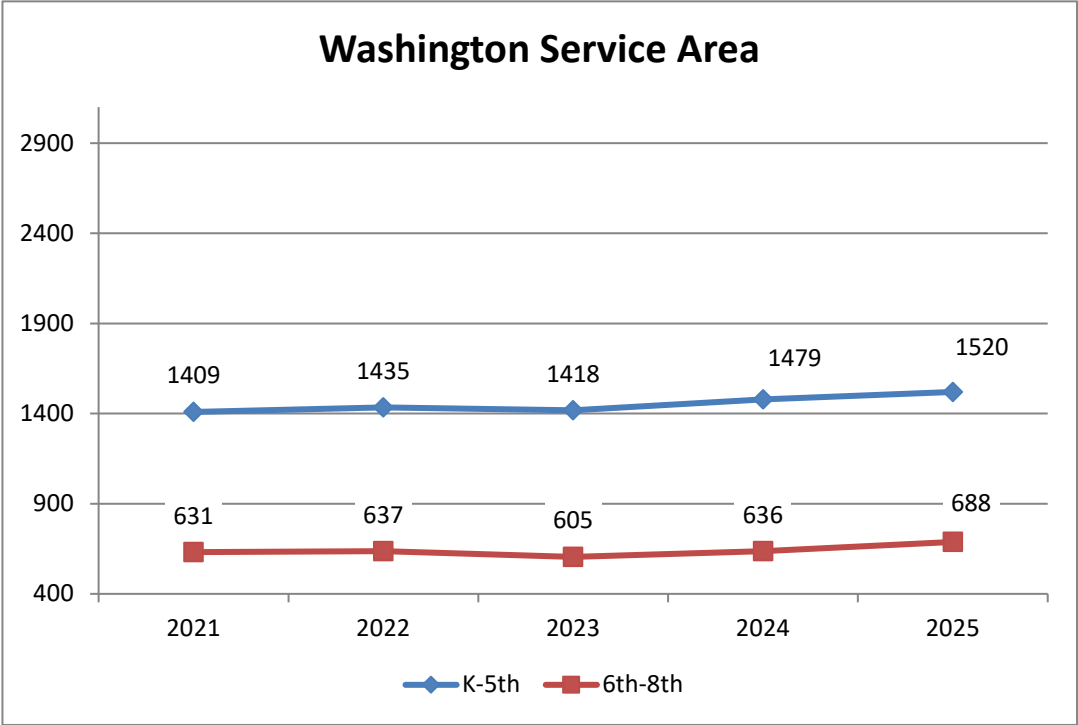
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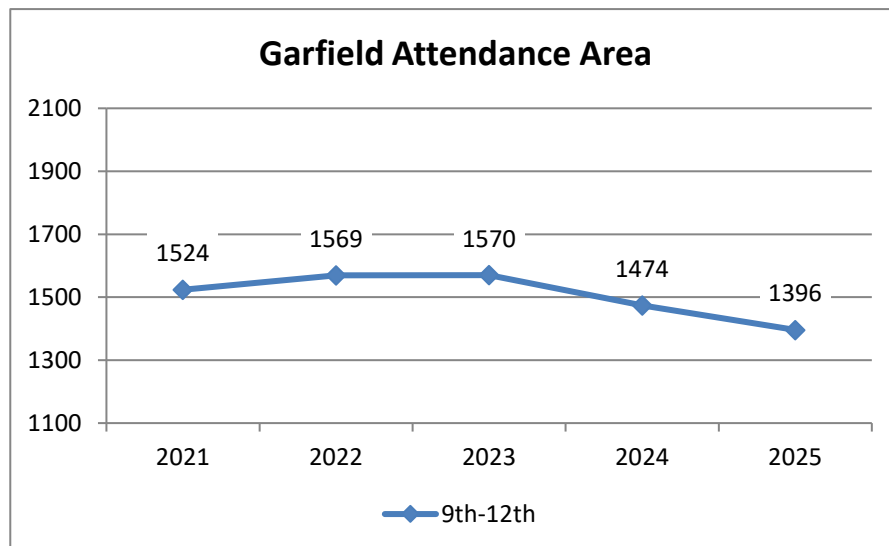
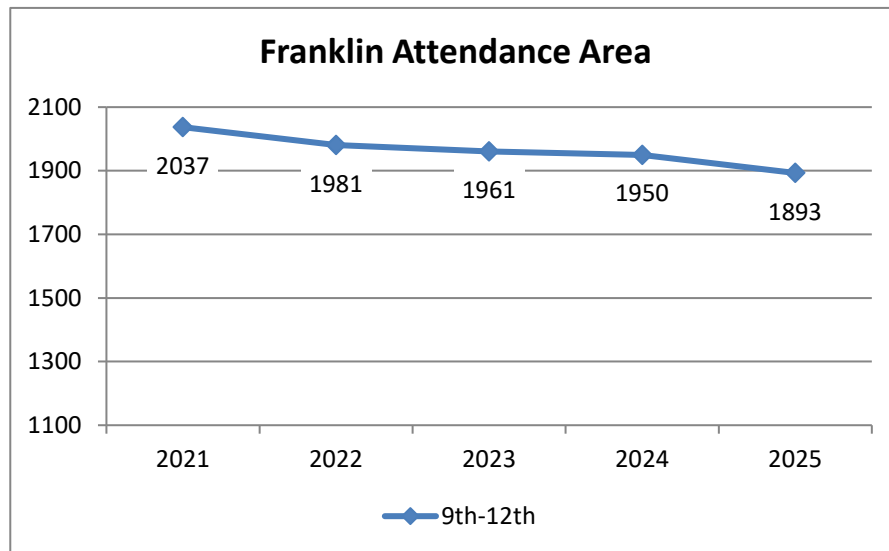
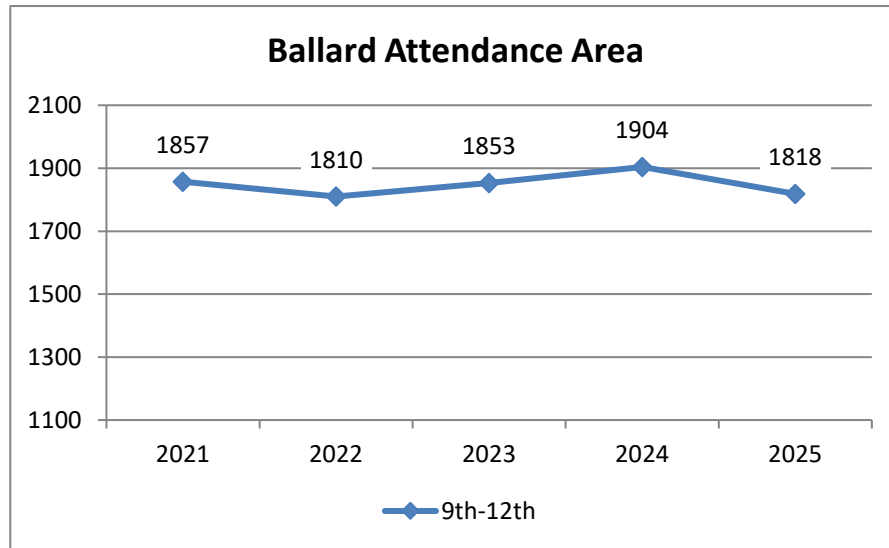


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Students Enrolled in SPS by Service Area of Residence (Where Students Live)

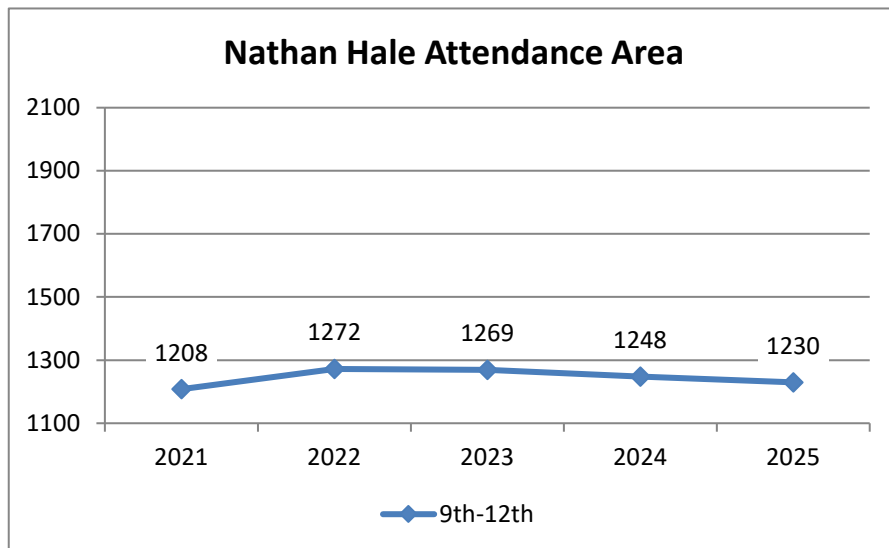
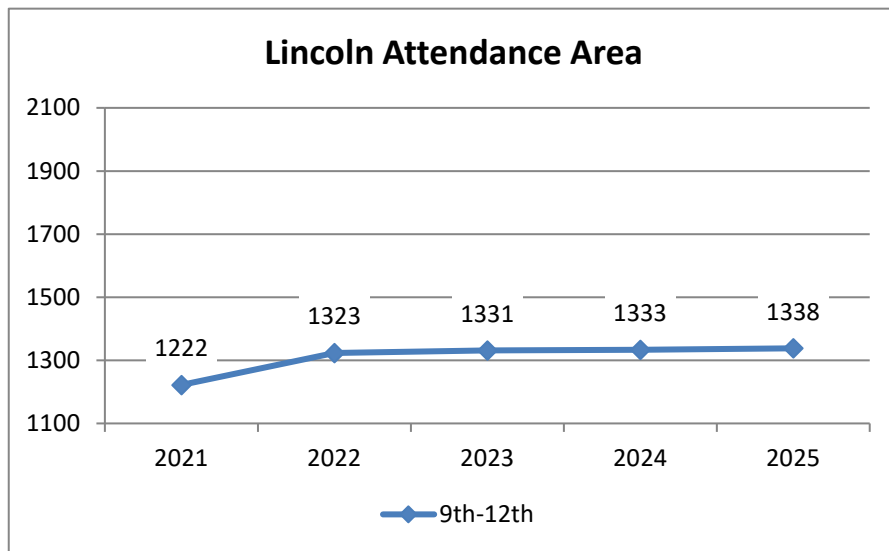
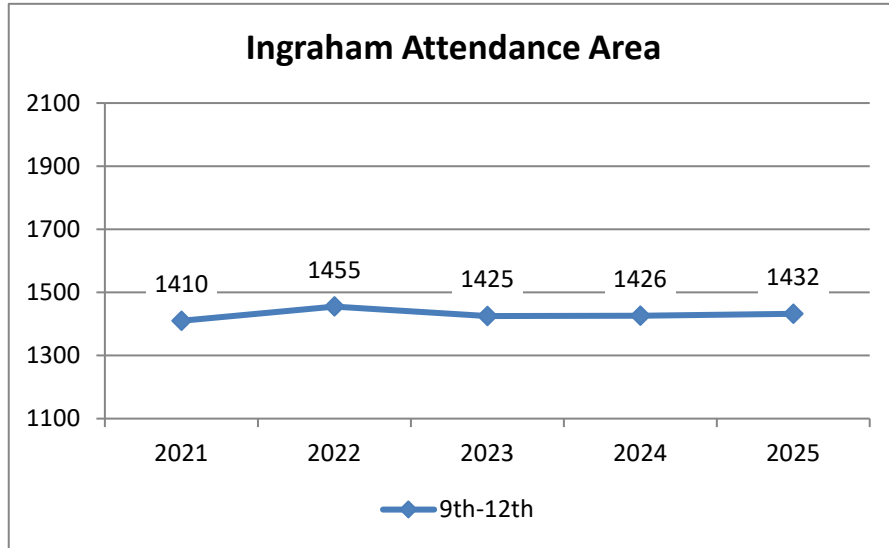

Students Enrolled in SPS by High School Attendance Area of Residence (Where Students Live)

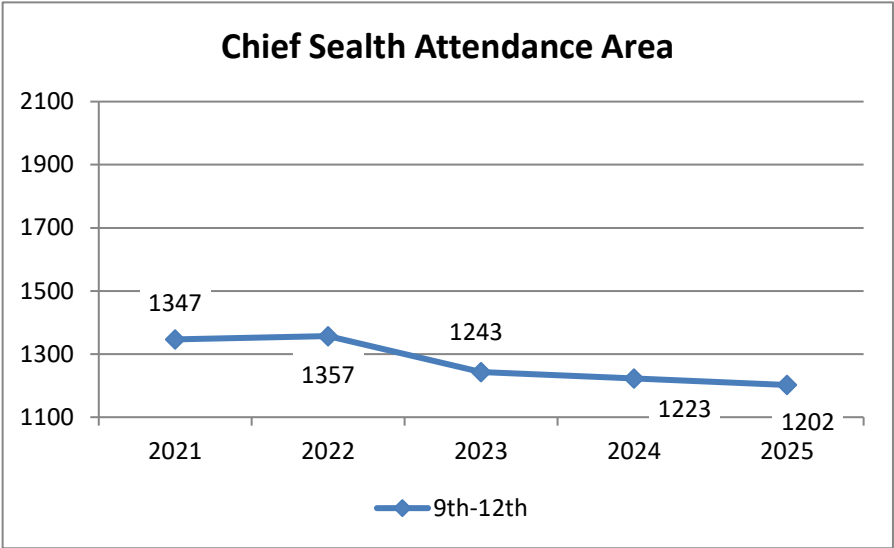
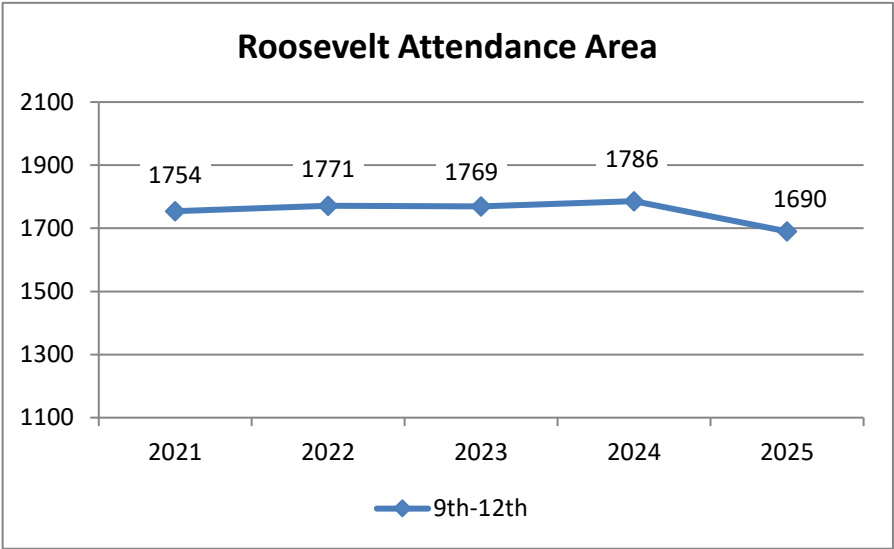
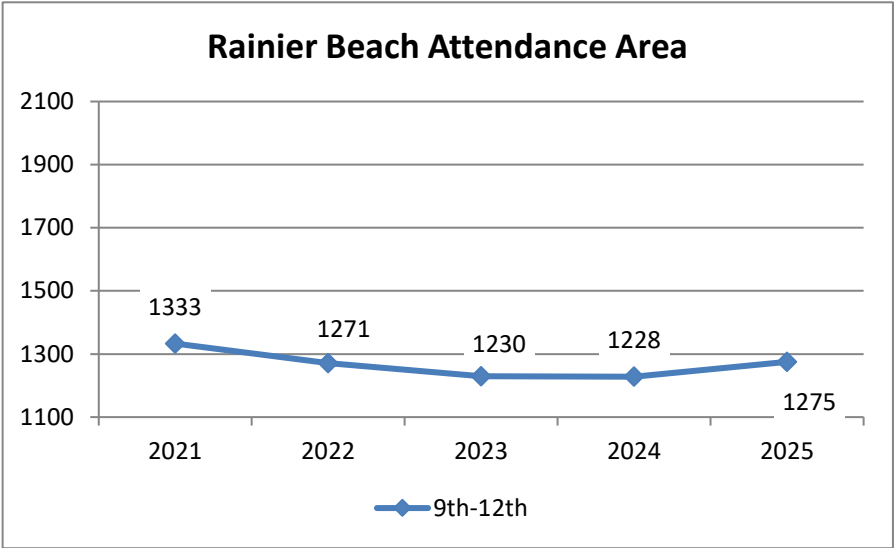


Students Enrolled in SPS by High School Attendance Area of Residence (Where Students Live)



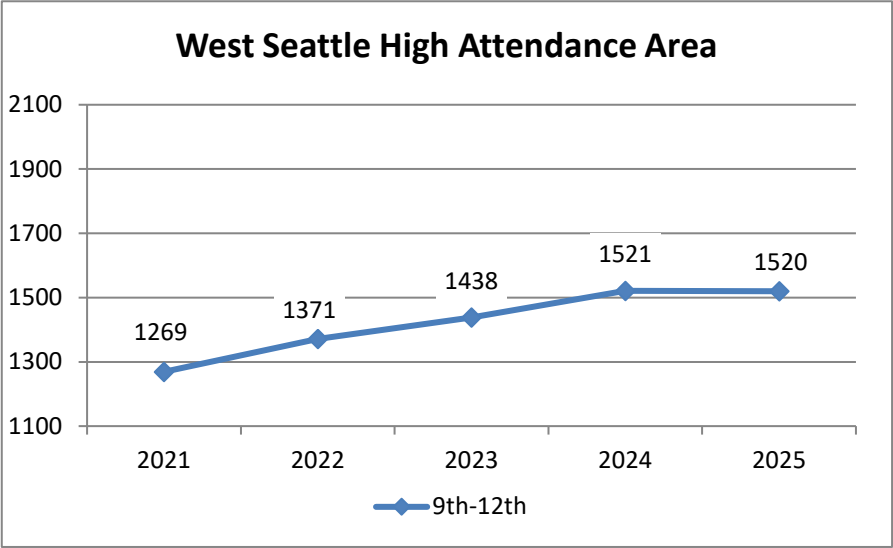

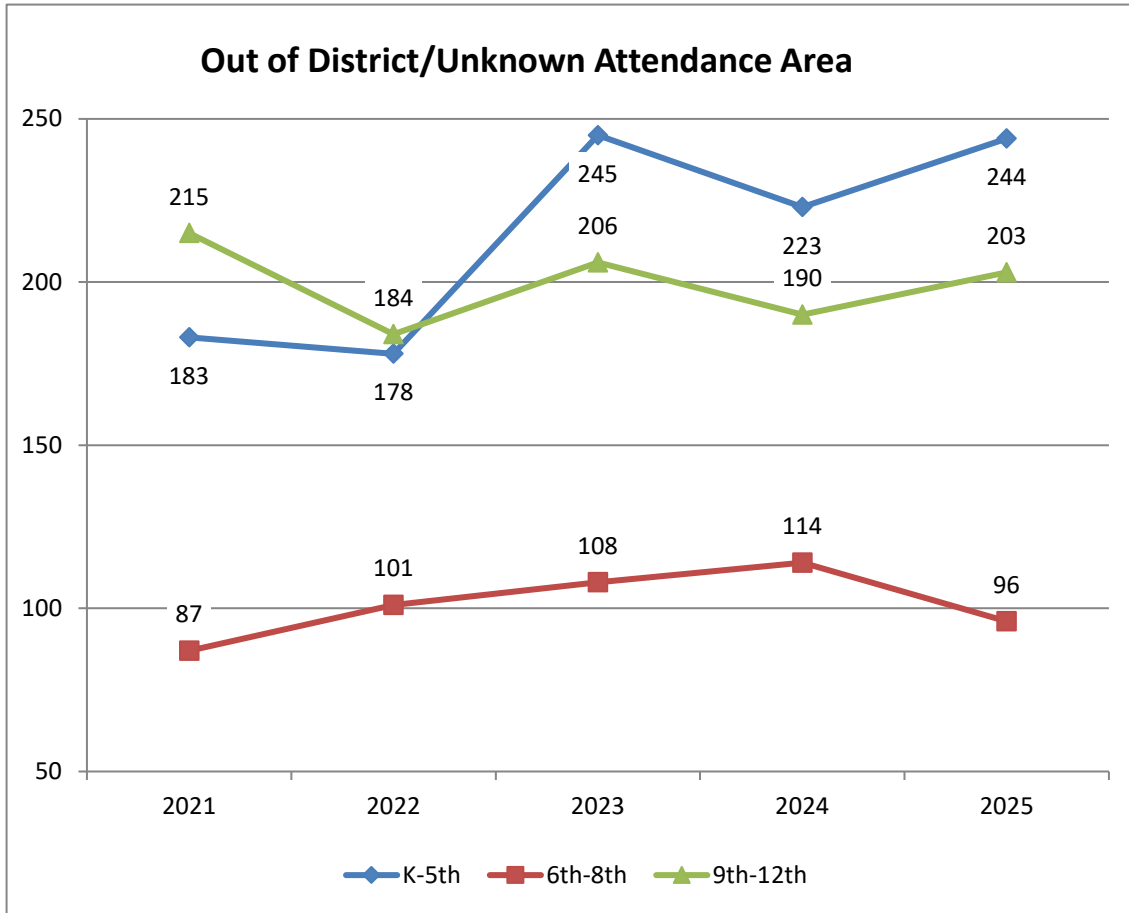
