



Documents for FAFSA

If YOU AND YOUR PARENT/GUARDIAN have any of the following:

• Social Security Number Found on Social Security card:



USCIS Number (if you are not a U.S. citizen)
Found on Green Card (Permanent Residence Card):



• Federal income tax returns, W-2s, and other records of money earned.

Copy of **2021 Tax Return** (Most often a 1040, 1040A, or 1040EZ):



2021 W-2 (will look similar to image below):



Note: You may be able to transfer your federal tax return information into your FAFSA using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool.

- **Driver's license number** (if applicable)
- Bank statements
- Records of untaxed income (if applicable)
- Additional financial information (if applicable)
 - Child support statements
 - o TANF or welfare information
 - Real estate or stocks and bonds investments
 - o Family business or farm information
- An FSA ID to sign electronically
 - If you have not done so already, create an FSA ID for yourself and a parent/guardian at https://fsaid.ed.gov/npas/index .htm






Documents for WASFA

- I-797 form (if applicable)



- Additional financial information (if applicable)
 - Child support statements
 - o TANF or welfare information
 - Real estate or stocks and bonds investments
 - o Family business or farm information

- Current or expired DACA status (if applicable)
- 2021 federal income tax returns, W-2s, and other records of money earned
