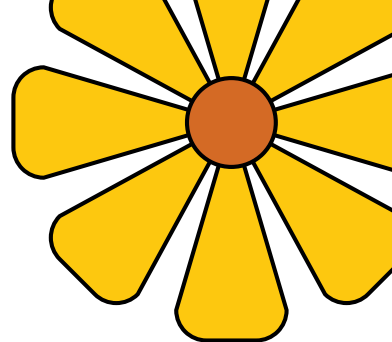




College Prep CHECKLIST



11th Fall - College Planning

Admissions Requirements - Check your college's website for requirements to make sure your credits are aligned ☐

Campus Visits - Tour local campuses to get a feel for different campus culture, size, and type you are interested in ☐

College Events - Visit college fairs like NACAC, sign up for college info sessions, and meet college reps that visit the high school ☐

Prepare your College List - Start your list of colleges. Talk to the adults in your life about how they chose their college ☐

11th Spring - Preparation

Jobs and Internships - Seek employment or internship opportunities that are related to your career path ☐

Volunteer - Seek volunteer opportunities that are in your field of interests or passions. Clubs and community events have plenty! ☐

Personal Statements - Draft your college essays or personal statements. Review college prompts and jot down ideas ☐

Scholarship - Create a scholarship search account and review scholarships on our website ☐

11th Fall - Career Exploration

Resume Building - Create and revise your resume to highlight your current and past activities, skills, and interests ☐

Career Fairs - Attend local fairs and meet organizations and businesses for potential hirings and networking ☐

Career Lists - Make a list of careers that may interest you and research the education level required for each profession ☐

Extracurriculars - Enhance skills that would be useful in a career of interests by joining a club, sport, getting a job, or volunteering ☐

11th All-Year - Tips

Job for Credit - If you are 16 and you have a job (paid or unpaid), you can earn 0.5 credit and an A! Talk to Mr. Brian to sign up ☐

Service Learning - This is a great opportunity to showcase your passions and skills outside of the classroom ☐

Informational Interview - Network with professionals on their education and/or career path. Learn from their experiences ☐

Personal Statements - As you're drafting your essay, it's important to have others read it to give perspective. Have at least 2 readers ☐

11th Fall - Academics

Advanced Placement - Prepare for AP exams in the Spring. Research colleges that grant college credit based on specific AP scores ☐

Running Start - Plan out your Running Start schedule for the year. Determine if you are attempting to earn an Associate's Degree ☐

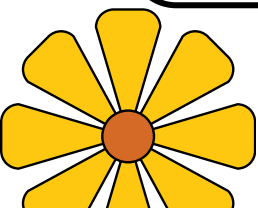
12th Grade Schedule - Consider additional rigorous courses, and possibly earn both high school and college credits ☐
