

Hello SPS Families,

Thank you for your patience and flexibility as we've been navigating a challenging year. 2021-2022 school year registration will take place electronically this year in order to maintain the usual scheduling timeline. Our collective goal as a district is to create school schedules that will serve all students despite the hardships of this school year.

Registration is a time for students to indicate their interest in course requests for next year. When processing requests, the scheduling system prioritizes students closest to graduation. Requests are not processed based on date of submission. Please use the steps below to help your students complete their 2021-2022 course registration.

Chief Sealth International High School's future 9th grade students will be requesting all 2021-2022 courses using the online registration tool. All students will be automatically enrolled a full year of Language Arts, Math, Social Studies and Science based upon their 8th grader courses. Therefore, students will only be selecting their final 2 credits online.

A few important notes to consider:

- A basic **Instructional Video** and **Power Point** that will walk families through the general process of using the online scheduling tool are available on the Chief Sealth website.
- Students considering the **Full IB Program** which starts in their Junior year are encouraged to take World Language as a Freshman.
- Students with an IEP or in the ELL program will also select their courses online and their IEP case
 manager or ELL teacher will be coordinating with the Middle School staff regarding their course
 selections.
- **Zero Period** classes that are offered in the morning before school are a great way to increase the number of credits earned. Those courses are optional and *might* be offered at the start of the 2021-22 School year.
- Freshman interested in participating in the **Spanish Immersion Program** (also called the Dual Language Program) will need to select AP Spanish 5 (1.0 credits) as a part of their final 2 credits.
- The Course Request window will be open from Monday May 3rd at 5p Monday May 10th at 10p
