In $10^{\text {th }}$ grade, you will take Intro to Engineering $1 \& 2$.
$\square$ School of Computer Science (SOCS)
This pathway allows students to explore topics in Computer Science such as Intro to Programming, Immersive Media, AP Computer Science Principles and AP Computer Science, with the option to take Projects in Computer Science in $12^{\text {th }}$ Grade.
In $10^{\text {th }}$ grade, you will take AP Computer Science Principles $1 / 2$.
