## **Cleveland Graduation Requirements Overview**



24 credits are required for graduation. The credit requirements are minimums both in terms of total credits required for graduation and for credits in the various subject areas. SPS graduation requirements meet most college entrance requirements (CADRS) for WA State schools. Some colleges may require additional courses. At Cleveland students will earn more credits and can potentially meet the Career & Technical Education (CTE) through a STEM (CTE) Pathway.

To check your credit status, you can login to The Source and look at your historical grades. #### **Graduation Pathway**

Students must complete at least one Graduation Pathway but are encouraged to complete as many as to align with their career and additional goals. At Cleveland students can meet this pathway by taking their STEM (CTE) pathway. The three graduation pathways are 1) English Language Arts (ELA) + Math, 2) Career & Technical (CTE) for two full years and 3) Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB).
