(2) If you have completed two years of Spanish or Chinese in middle school, you may sign up for a third year of Spanish or Chinese.
(3) If you are currently taking a music class and wish to continue, select 'YES' to the questions below and note which music class you are in.
(4) Review the courses offered below, select your Pathway preference, and write your Electives in the schedule on the right.
(5) Once completed, log on to the Source at http://ps.seattleschools.org. On the left side, there is a Course Registration tab that will lead you to the online registration screen.

Students will pick a STEM pathway in either School of Biomedical Life Sciences (SOLS), School of Engineering and Design (SOED) or School of Computer Science (SOCS) and take .50 credit elective per semester. Students will remain in the pathway for the next three years, with an optional fourth year.

Check the box of your preferred Pathway below:

- [] School of Biomedical Life Sciences (SOLS) This pathway allows students to explore topics in Life Sciences such as Applied Molecular Biology, Physiology, Biomedical Science and UW Biology 100. In 9th grade, you will be in Applied Molecular Biology.
[] School of Engineering and Design (SOED) This pathway allows students to explore topics in engineering such as Engineering Design and Development 1 & 2, Intro to Engineering 1 & 2 and Principles of Engineering 1 & 2. In 9th grade, you will take Engineering Design and Development 1 & 2.
[] School of Computer Science (SOCS) This pathway allows students to explore topics in Computer Science such as Intro to Programming, Immersive Media, AP Computer Science Principles and AP Computer Science, with the option to take Projects in Computer Science in 12th Grade. In 9th grade, you will take Intro to Programming and Immersive Media A.

- **College Success Foundation** The Achievers Program is open to 11th and 12th graders to receive support with college prep.
