- Applicant is a Senior attending an accredited college or trade school
- Completed Application is **DUE MARCH 31, 2022** and must include the following:
 - * Your Transcript (Unofficial is fine)
 - * Resume – list and date of academic awards, honors, high school activities, employment, or family support role
 - * 300–400-word Personal Statement
 - * Attach Reference from a non-family member (teacher, employer, etc.) or Provide a name and phone number of a reference we can call
