1. REQUIRED: Social Studies

A class on American government is required for 12th graders. Please select one.

2. REQUIRED: English Language Arts

A year of English Language Arts is required for 12th graders. Please select one.

- Bridge to College English
- UW in the High School: ENGL 131 Composition / COMP LIT 240 Margins Centers
- Comparative Literature and Composition
- AP English Literature and Composition

3. OPTIONAL: Math

If you have completed three years of math, a fourth year is optional but HIGHLY recommended.

- Bridge to College Math
- Math 141/142 Precalculus
- Math 107 Math in Society
- AP Statistics
- AP Calculus

If you have not taken or passed Algebra 2, you must enroll in Bridge to College Math. If you are on track to pass Algebra 2, pick Math 141 Precalculus, Math 107 Math in Society, or AP Statistics. Passing Math 141/142 Precalculus is required prior to taking AP Calculus.

Please select the course most appropriate to what math classes you will complete by the end of this current school year.

4. OPTIONAL: Science

If you have completed three years of science, a fourth year is optional but HIGHLY recommended.

- Forensics
- AP Physics
- AP Environmental Science

5. REQUIRED: Select Elective Classes

The Running Start program at the community college provides high school students the opportunity to enroll in college-level courses for college credit, tuition free, and earn high school credit at the same time.
