Sample Constitution and Bylaws of an ASB club. This needs to be typed up, submitted to club for approval, and when ratified, submitted to the Activities Coordinator via email before any fundraising can be approved.

Preamble (states the general purpose of your organization)
We, the students, for the promotion of good government, good sportsmanship, student activities and the general welfare of the students of Lincoln High School, establish this Constitution of the $\qquad$ Club.

Article I - Name of Organization - this section establishes the full, official name of your club the way it will be officially recorded.

Section A: It is resolved that the name of this organization shall be the $\qquad$ Club of Lincoln High School.

Article 2 - Purpose - this section describes the reason your club should exist and the purpose. It should be specifically connected to the mission of Lincoln High School, and is more specific than the preamble, which gives a big-picture view.
