SEC ENTRANCE PROCESS

1. Submit all documents
 - Completed Entrance Form
 - IEP/504 (if applicable)
 - Most recent SBA levels (7th or 8th grade, if available)
 - Discipline records
 - Attendance record for most recent completed school grading period – this can be printed from The Source for SPS students
 - Academic History – this can be obtained from your middle school counselor
 - Send all documents to Phillip Page at plpage@seattleschools.org. If unable to send electronically, please mail to 520 NE Ravenna Blvd, Seattle, WA 98115.
2. Attend an interview with SEC staff
3. Staff will review applications and determine placement in program
4. Families will receive notification of placement and next steps
