Language Arts [LA]

Math [MA]

You must select 1 year-long course, following the Math sequence (see Course Description Book and speak with your current Math teacher if you have questions about what course to take next):

Algebra 1 (includes Honors option) [MA]

Geometry (includes Honors option) [MA]

Algebra 2 (includes Honors option) [MA]

If you have already completed all three levels, select Algebra 2 (to complete your registration) and email your Roosevelt counselor to discuss the appropriate next Math course for you. Your counselor will change your request.

Science [SC]

One year of Science is required. The first course in the SPS Science sequence has already been selected for you:
