Science [SC]

All Sophomores must take a year of Science. If you took Physics A/Chemistry A in 9th grade, select:

If you took Biology in 9th grade and did not take Physics A/Chemistry A with Seattle Public Schools, select:

Physics A [SC] (the second semester of Chemistry A will be added for you later.)

If you completed a full year of both Physics A/Chemistry A (at Seattle Public Schools) and Biology, select Biology (to complete your registration) and email your Roosevelt counselor to discuss the appropriate next Science course for you. Your counselor will change your request.

Health [HE]

If you did not take health as a Freshman, you MUST sign up for it as a Sophomore: Health [HE]

Two years (or Personal Pathway) is required for graduation. Select one year-long course:
