Survey was distributed to families on paper and online the week of October 16, 2016.

Currently, the four high schools below have room for additional students, so if you choose one of these schools during Open Enrollment in February 2017, it's likely that your child could be placed there. In the case of Chief Sealth International High School, if it is designated as the **Dual Language Immersion Pathway** for the Mercer International 8th grade DLI cohorts in Spanish and Mandarin (at least for the next few years), the district would provide ORCA cards to students for transportation to the school. (Families would still need to explicitly choose Chief Sealth during Open Enrollment.)
